- Apply to at least **one lesson per week**.
- **Document lesson plan**, including your reflections, using one of the templates provided, or your own format.
  - Oct 19-Nov 8 - Identity
  - Nov 9 - Dec 6 - Add Power and Oppression
  - Dec 7 - Jan 17 - Add History of Resistance and Liberation
  - Jan 18 - Feb 1 - Add Healing and Futurity
- During this time, **collect student work samples** and **gather feedback**

# Preparing for Ethnic Studies Pedagogy


Charting: What do we want our pilot teachers to...
