

SPECIAL BOARD MEETING

October 25, 2019

The special meeting of the Baker School Board was called to order by Chairperson Gye Varner at 12:30 pm in the Boardroom of Baker High School. Trustees Quentin Burdick and Johnna Koenig were in attendance; Trustees Mike Gunderson and Klint Flint were absent. Also present were Superintendent Aaron Skogen, Principals David Breitbach and Bo Lingle, and District Clerk Jennifer Mettler. No guests were present.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING – BEA

Mr. Skogen states the Memorandum of Understanding with the Baker Education Association is due to the need of a contracted Long-Term Substitute in the elementary; the current Collective Bargaining Agreement does not address the employment of a Long-Term Substitute, therefore a MOU is needed to define this one-time instance.

Quentin Burdick moved to approve the Memorandum of Understanding between the Baker Education Association and the Baker School Board as presented. Johnna Koenig seconded the motion; motion carried unanimously.

LONG TERM SUBSTITUTE CONTRACT

Mr. Skogen presents to the board a Long-Term Substitute Contract for Patricia Morris. Pursuant to ARM 10.55.716, in the absence of a certified teacher for 35 days, a certified substitute must be contracted and employed during the absence. Mrs. Morris is a retired teacher and is able and willing to take on the long-term position until the elementary is able to return to work or until the end of the 2019-20 school year.

Discussion followed.

Johnna Koenig moved to approve the long-term substitute contract with Mrs. Patricia Morris as presented. Quentin Burdick seconded the motion; motion carried unanimously.
