The mission of Infnitec is to advance independence and promote inclusive opportunities for children and adults through the use of technology. Infnitec is a member-based organization and is **available to all District 834 employees only**.

This password-protected web-based portal offers staff access to a range of curriculum supports and professional learning opportunities. There are 100+ video and PowerPoint presentations from experts in the field and strategies for implementing technology with at-risk special education students. Infnitec also offers online quizzes for professional development credit, resource and research links, pre-made differentiated lesson plans, webinars, summarized instruction sheets on how to use common assistive technology devices and alternative activities are listed by subject.
