

## **Immunizations**

Every Fleming County School student must have a current **Kentucky State Immunization Certificate** on file within two weeks of enrollment. Check with your health department or wherever your child has received their immunizations to make sure they have received all required immunizations for entering school. Out of state certificates must be taken to the health department and transferred to Kentucky forms.

**KRS 158.035 Current up to date immunization certificate must be obtained within the first 2 weeks of enrollment.**

**KRS 214.990 Any person in violation of KRS 158.035 shall be guilty of a Class B misdemeanor.**

## **Physical Exam**

Students need proof of physical exam for kindergarten enrollment, for those entering sixth grade, and out of state transfers. These must be obtained prior to the October 15 deadline of the enrollment year.

## **Eye Examination**

Students ages 5 or 6 entering Fleming County Schools as a kindergarten student must have a vision exam completed by an optometrist or ophthalmologist by December 31 of the enrollment year.

## **Dental Examination/Screening**

Students age 5 or 6 years old entering Fleming County Schools as a kindergarten student must have a dental exam or screening within the calendar year of the student's enrollment. This is to be completed by a dentist, dental hygienist, physician assistant, APRN, physician or Local Health Department nurse with SMILE training.

## **Chronic Health Conditions**

Students who have chronic health conditions should have a primary health care provider establish the student's plan of care.

## **Screenings**

Students in Kindergarten, 2<sup>nd</sup> grade, and 5<sup>th</sup> grade will have hearing and vision screenings as stated by district guidelines.

Students K-8 will have vision screenings as well as height and weight screenings
