## Guidelines for Incurrible Juvenile Complaints

Before a complaint is filed, the parent **MUST** have made efforts to obtain counseling for the child and for themselves if necessary. These efforts must consist of more than one or two sessions with a licensed counselor. There should be repeated contacts with one or more counselors or agencies within ninety days prior to initial contact with your local DJJ office.

To confirm that these attempts have been made, the parent or guardian **MUST** provide a letter or memo from the agency or counselor verifying that counseling was given and was ineffective or that appointments were made which the child failed to keep. This letter should also indicate the amount of cooperation the parents provided, including a willingness to participate in family counseling if that was deemed appropriate.

The parent or guardian must also provide a written narrative of the events and circumstances surrounding their application for the complaint. This should also list any attempts, through counseling or otherwise, to remedy the situation at home. It is essential that this narrative is complete and truthful. The parents must sign the narrative and swear to its truthfulness. If the parents or guardian comply with the requirements as set out above, a complaint may be done.
