

SCHOOL BOARD MEMBERSHIPS IN PROFESISONAL ASSOCIATIONS

Code **BK** Issued **11/12**

Purpose: To establish the basic structure for board membership in associations.

The board may maintain a membership in the South Carolina School Boards Association and take an active part in the activities of the association, both as a group and as individual members. The district pays dues for this membership as authorized by law. It maintains an indirect membership in the National School Boards Association through its affiliation with the state group.
