What counts for attendance?

*Attendance is only recorded when the parent logs time into the student's Brightspace account.

The following activities may be counted toward attendance:

*Student attended a Live Session

*Student logged into a lesson or lesson activity, and the login can be documented (i.e. working on assigned classwork)

*There is documentation of activity/work between the parent and student

*School-sanctioned group activities or individual activities per the student's Individual Learning Plan (ILP)

*If your student is involved in extracurriculars or taking a college course, please inform your Guidance Counselor.





PARENT/LC

*Daily monitoring of student.

*Daily interaction with student to ensure active engagement

*Maintaining & logging attendance daily.

*Ensuring consistent academic progress.

*Checking emails daily & responding as required in a timely manner.

*Ensuring student's assignments are completed on or before due dates.

*Notifying Mehry Mohammadi if your student will be missing school at attendance@mainevirtualacademy.org

*Ensuring student participates in all required school activities.

*LC's can actively provide feedback through surveys throughout the school year.

*Parents can request meetings at anytime in ZOOM

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Student Responsibilities

*Logging into the online school and classes daily (as required by MEVA's attendance policy in the School Handbook)

*Checking emails daily and responding as required in a timely manner

*Completing each assignment listed in the class content for each course *Attending and actively participating in live sessions

*Submitting assignments on or before due dates

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Dedicated Learning Space



It is important to have a dedicated workspace set up for your student and a strong internet connection.

When figuring out the best location to set up your learning space, consider the following:

Find an appropriate spot in your home. How is the lighting? Is there enough space for schooling?

Consider the furniture placement. Ensure the desk or table for your student is an appropriate size, and that it is free from clutter. Make sure you have shelving and space to store the learning materials.

How is the internet connection? This is very important - your student is learning online. If you already know that your learning space has poor internet connection, either move the router closer to your student's space, or find a better location.

Are there distractions? Rooms with televisions, gaming systems, or lots of toys will make it difficult for your student to concentrate.

Are you dressed and ready for the day? Changing into school clothes can make a big difference in your attitude. Make sure you wake up with plenty of time before school and prepare yourself for the day!
