

Bus Riding Made Easy

- Students need to arrive at the bus pick up location 5 minutes prior to pick up time.
- Prk-1 need to have parent/guardian at bus stop location at pick up and drop off time, or the driver will not let student off bus.
- Parents/guardians are also reminded that they are responsible for the safety of their child while going to or coming from the bus stop and while waiting at the bus stop.
- It's the law while unloading the bus the child must proceed to their place of safety and stay there until the bus leaves.
- Remember that 10 feet around the bus is a "DANGER ZONE" the driver can't see you!
- Students must get on and off at assigned stop locations.
- If you are planning on moving please contact Transportation office at least 3 days prior so there is ample time to process new stop locations and bus times.
- If you miss the bus please do not run after the bus and or chase bus down in your personal vehicle to next bus stop. Drivers can't see the child and not expecting them.
- The child should only carry those things on the bus that will fit on their laps.

Triad Transportation Board of Education Policies

1. There will be **NO** daily passes to go home with someone else.
2. Students will have only one pick-up and drop-off location each semester. (Due to child care needs the pick-up location maybe different than drop-off location)
3. Emergency request for bus route changes will only be approved in family emergency situations and only if the transportation office is notified in writing and the alternative stop is available on a current route. These request must be received by the transportation office by 12:00PM
4. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian not the school, to solve temporary scheduling problems by arranging rides or supervision with relatives or neighbors. Daily request is very difficult to process and an error can result in a child arriving somewhere they are not expected.
