

## TUITION INCOME

Code **DFG** Revised **12/12**

---

Purpose: To establish the basic structure for collection of tuition from nonresident students.

The board may collect tuition from nonresident students enrolled in the district's schools. The board may set or reconfirm the fee on an annual basis. The fee is based on the per pupil cost of district funds (see also JFAB – Admission of Nonresident Students). A surcharge may be included in lieu of property ownership as detailed in policy JFAB.

The district may collect tuition in advance of enrollment. The district deposits such funds to the general school account.
