

SCHOOL PROPERTIES DISPOSITION

Code **DN** Revised **12/12**

Purpose: To establish the basic structure for disposal of property which is no longer needed.

The superintendent will advise the board that certain property is no longer needed for public school purposes. The board may sell or lease school property, real or personal, whenever such property is no longer needed for school purposes. The district will apply proceeds of any such sale or lease to the school funds of the district.

The state board of education must approve, in advance and in writing, the reassignment or disposal of parcels of land purchased after 1952 with any state funds.
