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## Graduation Requirements

### *Class of 2024 & Beyond*

#### Credit Requirements

Earn 46 semester credits in the following areas:

1 semester = 1.0 credit = ½ year

2 semester = 2.0 credits = full year

English .....8 credits (English 9, 10, 11, 12)

Social Studies.....8 credits (Civics, W. History, US History, Sr. Social Studies Selections)

Math .....6 credits\* (3 Years of math through Adv. Algebra or equivalent)\*\*

Science .....6 credits\* (1 Year Biology, 1 year Chem. or Physics & 1 year elective)\*\*

Health.....1 credit

Physical Ed. ....1 credit

Fine Arts .....2 credits (ex. Music, Drawing, Painting, etc.)

Info/Comm. Lit.....1 credit (9th grade)

Park Connections.....1 credit over 4 years through Park Connections class (.25 per year)  
(SEL/Career & College Readiness)

Electives .....12 credits total (in the areas listed below)

#### Additional Electives:

12 credits – Extra classes taken in: Art, Business, English, Math (ex. 4th year of Math), Music, Phy.Ed, Science, Social Studies, World Language\*, or any of the classes in the Career Pathways of Study

#### **\*Strongly Suggested Additional Course Work for Admission to:**

- Minnesota State University (MNSCU System) - 2 or more years of a world language, 3-4 years of math & science
- University of Minnesota – 2 or more years of a world language, 4 years of math, 4 years of science
- Minnesota Private Colleges/Selective Colleges – 2 or more years of world language, 4 years of math, 4 years of science

\*\* If students have met their requirement, there are classes noted in the course catalog that can count for the elective portion of their required math or science credit (ie. third year of math after Advanced Algebra or the elective Science credit) Look for Math Elective or Science Elective in the course description.

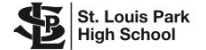

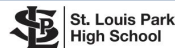

- Things to consider regarding selecting Honors/AP courses.
  - Grades (7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> Grade)
  - NWEA-MAP Test Scores (Reading & Math) if available.
  - Work habits/extracurricular activities
- Students can self select into individual courses to make more appropriate choices to balance their schedules (and lives) to ultimately do better in the subjects where they feel most confident.
- In previous years we have had very high numbers of students who were interested in Honors course work.



- After a specified time there will be limited switches from Honors to Regular courses – changes would only happen at the semester.
- Honors Math (Hon Adv Alg & Precalc) has a specific performance contract that you will sign off on if you select that level once the class is started.
