Q: Will Summer Driver's Ed be offered this year?

A: YES, an orientation meeting will be held during “Phoenix Preview” February 13th at 6:30 in the Auditorium. Mr Spendlove is the instructor (sjspendlove@dsdmail.net).

Q: Can I sign up to take the classroom portion of Driver’s Ed online with Davis Connect?

A: Yes, summer sign up information is coming soon from Davis Connect.

Q: If I take Driver’s Ed during the school year, how do I know which term I can take the course?

A: The computer system will place you in the correct term based on your birthday.

Q: Can I take Marine Biology and or Ornithology as a Sophomore?

A: NO, students must complete 2 courses from the state approved listing of core science offerings. The core courses offered at FHS are: Biology, Chemistry, Physics, AP Biology, AP Chemistry, AP Physics 1 and AP Physics C.

Q: Do hard copies of the course requests need to be returned?

A: No, hard copies are not required. All registration will be online. High School counselors will visit Centennial junior high Feb 16, 17 and Farmington Junior High Feb. 23, 24, 2023

Q: How can I make changes to a course request after it has been submitted?

A: Changes can be made on myDSD until March 16. After that you can email your assigned counselor until the end of the school year

Q: How to register a student with an IEP

A: Contact your File Holder at your Junior High for instructions.

Q: How do I know what my student needs to meet graduation requirements?

A: In your MyDSD account go to Academics > reports > graduation summary. The graduation summary will organize the courses your student has taken into the categories where they need credit for graduation.

Q: Can I put home release or teacher assistant type classes as part of my course requests?

A: NO, it is required that students fill out their course requests with 8 first semester choices, 8 second semester choices and 3 alternate choices. Home release must be requested in the fall and TA is not an option for sophomore students.

Q: Do I have to take Fit for Life? Will team athletics count for Fit for Life?

A: Fit for Life is required to graduate from high school.

A: Team athletics/Marching Band/Drill/Cheer taken during the school day can count for Fit for Life *if additional Canvas course work is completed in conjunction with the class*. Talk with your coach for details
