

DEVELOP STUDENTS

Nearly all NVCA's resources support the school's primary mission to educate students. Of the \$7,036,613 million in annual expenses, approximately 81 percent supports education comprising faculty and staff salaries, benefits, and instructional support. The remaining 19 percent of NVCA's expenditures includes facilities maintenance and debt service.

EXCEED GOALS

The cost of an NVCA education significantly exceeds the full cost of tuition for each student. To supplement the additional 36 percent needed to pay for each student's education, NVCA relies on the generous donations of current parents, grandparents, board members, churches, and community members.

During the 2021-2022 school year, we celebrated many achievements and firsts:
