

## **COMPENSATORY EDUCATION/ REMEDIAL INSTRUCTION**

Code **IHBD/IHBD A** Revision **3/13**

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Purpose: To establish a basic structure to implement an appropriate kindergarten through three curriculum model supportive of the curriculum for grades four through twelve.

### **Early childhood assistance programs, grades kindergarten through three/academic assistance programs, grades four through twelve**

The district will emphasize early childhood education and prevention and promote assistance for students at each grade level geared to their individual needs and learning styles.

The district will be flexible in designing and providing targeted academic assistance plans for kindergarten through three and grades four through twelve students to accelerate the performance of students performing below their peers.

The district will identify students for academic assistance based on failure to meet state testing standards, teacher judgment of benefits to students, or district or school criteria developed for academic assistance.

For funding purposes, the district will collect and report the number of kindergarten through three students on free and reduced-price lunches. The district may request a waiver to use a portion of the kindergarten through three funds for students in grades four through twelve if such a move increases coordination of state and federal funds.
