

ADULT/COMMUNITY EDUCATION

Code **IHD** Revised **3/13**

Purpose: To establish the basic structure for adult/community education.

The district provides adult education programs which meet the following criteria.

- Prepare students for the state high school equivalency examination.
- Offer courses leading to a high school diploma.
- Provide courses in basic education subjects.

The adult program may offer courses in job training, employment skills, enrichment and continuing education.

The district may provide opportunities for community education as desired and requested by community members. The program will be totally self-supporting. The district may sponsor the community education program alone or in cooperation with other community agencies.

Enrollment

The district will limit enrollment in adult education programs to individuals who are age-appropriate as dictated by relevant state law and who have left the elementary or secondary school.

The district may assign individual students less than 18 years of age with the approval of the superintendent. These students may be assigned to one or more classes of an adult education program under these circumstances.
