BACKGROUND INFORMATION

SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLANS (SIP) 2020-2021:

- Each school is required to have their SIP approved by the school board of directors each year. (WAC180-16-220)
- Washington State follows a three year cycle in which schools are identified for supports based on various measures of student performance and school quality using Washington State Improvement Framework (WSIF) measures.
- School year 2020-21 is the third year of the current ESSA cycle; 2021-2022 is the first year of the next ESSA cycle (federal requirement for accountability).
- Required contents of the SIP:
 - Characteristics of successful schools
 - Educational equity factors
 - The use of technology to facilitate instruction
 - Parent, family, and community involvement
- This study session will address key design questions to guide SHSD school SIPs:
 - What specific content will be included?
 - What is the preferred layout of the document?
 - How will schools monitor, adjust and update their SIPs?
- Paul Harvey will review different models of SIP plans and make recommendations to the board.
- The board will provide guidance which can be taken to the principals for directions in crafting SIPs in a common format.
