Welcome:

- Leslie Bertram welcomed everyone

Security:

- Both the city and school district are happy with the signs.
- Police are doing patrols. They will continue to patrol the area for the remaining year.
- Our school is not big enough for the flashing light signs.

BTS Art Programs:

- Mr. Smith has gone to businesses to get donations for the BTS program.
- He has spoken to In and Out, Dicks, Papa Murphy's, and other businesses.

Kindergarten:

- We want to start finding students who will be in kindergarten here at Centerville Elementary.

 - The PTA has offered to help with this as well.

MOY Data Review:

- Reading:
 - Last year we started the year with 67% of students reading at grade level. We ended the year with 71% of students reading on grade level.
 - This year we started with 67% of students reading on grade level. After the MOY testing, we have 65% of students reading on grade level.
 - According to the data, students reading on, or above grade level have increased.
 - The end of year state goal is 75% of students are reading at or above grade level. We are near the state goal.
 - We look at the Pathways to Progress Data. We want to see all students grow either typically, above, or well above growth.
- Math:
 - RISE Comparison Proficiency: we are above the district goal. We would like to see additional growth.
 - Acadience Math scores: we have shown growth, but we do have students who are below or well below. We would like to see an increase in proficiency.

- We want to make more progress in math.
- Should we have an aide who helps students with math facts. We are working on math facts.
- We plan to hire an aide to help students learn their math facts next year.
 - We will be focusing on math facts as a school and in individual classes.
 - Would it be helpful to have a place for parents to get ideas for helping their children learn math facts and reading?
 - Can parents check out games to help students learn their math facts?
- Teacher Survey:
 - The teachers really liked the BTS program.
 - Teachers said that they would like Teacher Aides for next year.
 - We talked about what a behavior aide is and what they do.
 - We want to help students get back to class and not have them out of class.
 - We talked about what a team recess is and why it would be beneficial.
