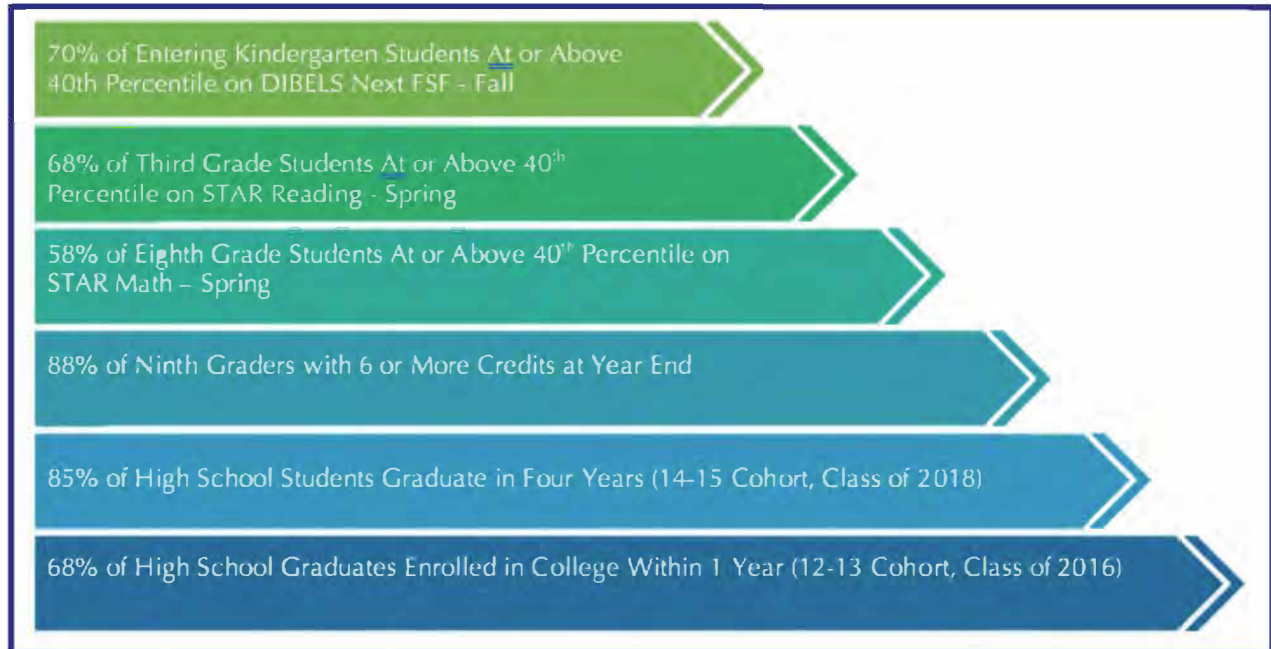


2017-2018 Key Performance Indicators Results



Kindergarten Readiness:

District staff determined the 40th percentile on DIBELS Next First Sound Fluency for entering kindergarteners was the standard for indicating future academic success. In 2017-2018, 70 percent of kindergarten students entering the district were at this level. This is the first year with this measure so there is no comparison to previous performance.

Third Grade Reading Proficiency:

Third grade reading proficiency, as measured by STAR Reading, improved from 60 percent in 2016-17 to 68 percent in 2017-18 – an eight percentage point increase.

Eighth Grade Algebra Ready:

Eighth grade math proficiency, as measured by STAR Math, increased from 55 percent in 2016-2017 to 58 percent in 2017-2018 – a three percentage point increase. 8th Graders also saw an improvement in Smarter Balanced achievement with 46% proficient in 2017-2018 compared to 41% in 2016-2017.

Freshman On-Track:

The district saw the percentage of 9th graders earning six or more credits raise by one percentage point compared to 2017. North Clackamas results continue to outpace the state average (88 percent for North Clackamas compared to 85 percent for Oregon). North

Clackamas has seen the 9th Grade On-Track percentage increase by five percentage points over the past five years.

Graduation Results:

The district’s 2018 overall four-year graduation rate increased by one percentage point to a four-year graduation rate of 85 percent. This is the district’s all-time highest graduation rate, **13 percentage points higher than six years ago.**

The district’s overall **five-year graduation rate rose to 87 percent** – a two percentage point increase over 2017. The current rate is 16 percentage points higher than it was six years ago.

Enrollment in Post-Secondary Education after Graduation:

68 percent of North Clackamas graduates were enrolled in community college or a four-year college within one year after their high school graduation. The district’s 68 percent enrollment rate increased slightly but the measure has changed as well. *In previous years measurement was taken at 16 months following graduation rather than 12.
