Monroe-Gregg Board of School Trustees Minutes of the Regular Meeting Administration Office February 8, 2021

The regular meeting of the Monroe-Gregg Board of School Trustees began with the Pledge of Allegiance.

#### **CALL TO ORDER**

The meeting was called to order by President, Mrs. Celina Clements at 6:37 P.M., in the Administration Office conference room. Board members in attendance were: Mr. Jack Elliott, Mr. Brock Sears, Mr. Tom Kennedy and Mr. Tim Pridemore. Superintendent, Dr. Kirk Freeman; Mr. Steve Harris, School Attorney; and MGTA Representative Ashley Stephens were also present.

Dr. Freeman commended the students for their accomplishments. He also took the opportunity to thank the Monrovia Alumni Association for their sponsorship.

## PUBLIC COMMENT ON AGENDA ITEMS

There were no comments on agenda items.

#### **CONSIDERATION OF MINUTES**

The motion was made by Mr. Pridemore to approve the executive session and regular board meeting minutes of January 19, 2021 as presented. Mr. Elliott seconded and the motion carried 5-0.

#### **CONSIDERATION OF CLAIMS**

Mr. Kennedy made the motion to approve claims #3745 through #3867 as presented in the amount of \$3,300,650.77. Seconded by Mr. Sears, the motion carried 5-0.

#### **CONSIDERATION OF PERSONNEL RECOMMENDATIONS**

Dr. Freeman recommended the Board approve the Personnel Report as presented. He shared with the Board that Mr. Tucker is fully licensed as a principal now, hence the increased pay recommendation. Mr. Sears made the motion to approve all personnel recommendations as presented. The motion was seconded by Mr. Pridemore, motion carried 5-0.

## **CONSIDERATION OF 2021-2022 STUDENT TRANSFERS.**

Mr. Elliott made a motion to approve the updated Student Transfer Application for the 2021-2022 school year. Mr. Sears seconded, motion carried 5-0.

#### **BOARD POLICY UPDATES AND CHANGES**

Mr. Kennedy made a motion to table policy numbers 1220, 3220, and 6325 but approve all other policies as recommended. Mr. Pridemore seconded the motion as presented by Mr. Kennedy. Motion passed 5-0.

#### **CONSIDERATION OF NEW BUSES**

Mr. Sears made the motion to approve the purchase of three (3) new buses at a total cost of \$300,993.00. Mr. Elliott seconded and the motion carried 5-0. Dr. Freeman shared with the Board that due to the recent bus fire, bus number 6 will need to be replaced. The insurance company will be covering a majority of the replacement cost.

# CONSIDERATION OF SALARY & BENEFIT INCREASE FOR ADMINISTRATORS AND CLASSIFIED STAFF

Dr. Freeman recommended all administrators, directors, nurses, and central office staff receive the same \$1500 stipend that the teachers received earlier in the year.

He also recommend that all classified staff receive a 51cent/hour pay raise. Bus drivers would receive a flat rate of \$3.57 per day. This will be retroactive to February 1, 2021.

Mr. Pridemore made the motion to approve the salary and benefit recommendation as presented, seconded by Mr. Sears. Motion carried 5-0.

#### **OTHER**

Dr. Freeman publicly thanked Lieutenant Bryan Magennis for quickly taking charge of the recent bus fire. His efficient and calm manner was an asset to our school district.

Dr. Freeman shared a recent newspaper article by Reporter, Cody Thompson highlighting the graduation rates around the county. The article reflected positively for Monrovia High School and the entire school district.

## **ADJOURNMENT**

Mr. Elliott made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Mr. Sears. Mrs. Clements adjourned the meeting at 6:46 P.M.
