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Dear Students, Staff and Families,



Positive Behavior Interventions And Supports:

- o Each school has a specific PBIS team to lead the activities that support the ongoing building of a positive school culture, and recognizing students who contribute positively to the development of a positive school culture.

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
- Boys and girls basketball and boys and girls track, and winter cheer will open their season the week of December 13th. All game schedules can be located in arbiterlive.com
