Health Agent- Part-Time

The Town of Southampton seeks qualified candidates for the part-time position of Health Agent.

Must have working knowledge of the state environmental code, the state sanitary code, food service regulations, and all other laws, rules, and regulations pertaining to public health and sanitation. Thorough knowledge of state septic system regulations; working knowledge of current inspection and control procedures.

Works under the general direction of the Health Director and Board of Health. Performs highly responsible work of a complex and technical nature which involves the exercise of judgment and initiative to ensure the enforcement of applicable state, federal and local codes and regulations.

Required: Soil Evaluator certification and ServSafe Food Protection Manager certification required, and valid Class D Motor Vehicle Driver's license.

Preferred qualifications: Bachelor's degree in environmental science, public health or related field from an accredited university or college; one to three (1-3) years' experience in public health or a related field; or any equivalent combination of education and experience which provides the required knowledge, ability and skill to carry out the essential functions of the position.
