Election Worker

Job Description

Requirements:

- Must be a registered voter residing in the State of Massachusetts
- Must be able to read, write, and speak English
- Must attend a training session
- Must have own transportation to polling location

Basic Duties:

- Prepare the poll site for voters
- Check in voters, distribute ballots, count ballots, etc.
- Assist other Poll Workers as needed
- Be able to stand for long hours if necessary
- Be able to lift at least 20 lbs.

Hours and Location:

At minimum four-hour shift, although there is flexibility, as determined by the Precinct Warden at the Senior Center or at Norris School

Pay:

Pay rate is \$14.25 per hour for poll workers and the warden.

Application:
