4. Current School Improvement Plan Status Update – Principal Carmony

- MOY Acadience Reading Data
- Report on School Improvement Plan Goal # 1 and #2
 - Goal 1: MOY 66.8% of K-3 making typical or better progress, increase by 3% this year. This year, K-3 MOY is at 73%, so Goal #1 achieved!
 - Goal 2: Increase percentage of ELL making typical or better progress on MOY testing by 3%. We started at 55%, decreased to 50%. Did not meet goal.
 - Next time we will discuss the school plan to address this goal

5. Targeted Support. and Improvement (TSI) School – Principal Carmony

- New status explanation
 - RISE assessment used for accountability with TSI
- Implications for school plans
 - Need to make a specific plan in the school improvement plan
 - Every teacher must use material provided by the district with the appropriate number of minutes for each subject
