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## SCHOOL CHARACTERISTICS

- Founded in 1946
- 391 students from 54 countries
- Non-denominational, coeducational day school located in a suburb of Paris
- 14 athletics teams participating in ISST competitions throughout Europe
- 37 student-led organizations and clubs
- School day runs from 8:45 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
- Accredited by the Council of International Schools, Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools, International Baccalaureate, and participant in International Association for College Admission Counseling
- 100% of students go onto tertiary education

## ACADEMICS

- 24 IB and 15 AP courses offered, including possibility of mixed curriculum
- 29 IB Diploma candidates
- Semester schedule with 80-minute block schedule
- Minimum five academic courses per semester
- 400-level courses considered advanced College Prep
- All students study French in Grades 9 and 10
- Fully remote from March through June 2020, resulting in Pass/Fail grades for those terms
- Does not rank students or compute cumulative GPA, weighted GPA by semester is calculated on a five-point scale
- IB and AP predicted grades are calculated based on semester and exam grades (in the last two years with IB exams, approximately 65% of students were within one point (out of 45 possible) of overall prediction and 78% were within two points)
