Application Process

Fill out the application (including Flipgrid) and then complete two teacher recommendations



Timeline

March 30th- Applications due (all parts including flipgrid and teacher recommendations)

April 12th- Candidates will be informed of our decision. Top 6 will be invited for interviews.

April 14th- 7th grade officer interviews at 4 p.m.



Decision Process

All applicants are graded using the same rubric. 50% of the decision will be made by teacher recommendations, with the other 50% being judged by the advisor and a current student/teacher committee based on the Flipgrid and application.

Rubric Grading will be based on: **Oral Presentation** (speaking clearly, detailed explanations, body language, eye contact), **Enthusiasm**, Detailed or creative **input** on what they'll do at Legacy.

Teacher Recommendations

We'll look at recommendations sent by two teachers. We love getting feedback from our elementary teachers!

Student/Teacher Committee

A committee of students and teachers will follow the same rubric to grade the flipgrid. The average score will be taken.

Interview Process

The top 6 candidates will be interviewed (April 14th, 4 p.m.) by the 2023-2024 SBOs. The top 4 candidates will be chosen. Decisions will be made that day.
