BOARD PRESIDENT LETTER

The 2021 – 2022 school year was a year of transition and reflection. In late fall of 2021, Duncan Lyon announced his upcoming departure at the end of the academic year. A search committee was formed, search consultants were hired, and the yearlong process of finding a new Head of School began. This upcoming change in leadership also provided a valuable opportunity for us to get feedback from the community about their vision for the next chapter at Carey.

In parallel with our Head of School search, we kicked off Carey's first 2022 DEI climate audit, which provided a crucial platform to gather insights about the Carey experience from students, parents and guardians, faculty, staff, and alumni. We partnered with a highly respected consulting team to lead our audit – Dr. Valaida Wise and her team led focus groups, evaluated survey data, and conducted a review of our policies and procedures. Her team spent most of the spring and summer pulling together the qualitative and quantitative findings, which will serve as the basis for the recommendations in our upcoming DEI Action Plan. This work will also serve as the foundation for our next strategic plan.

We wrapped up the year with an exciting addition to the Carey campus. In June 2022, a property adjacent to our campus came onto the market. The board had spent significant time planning for this scenario, and we were ecstatic to seize a rare opportunity to expand our footprint and begin the process of long-term campus planning.

We also benefited from another successful Annual Fund, thanks to 100% participation from parents, board, faculty, and staff. We raised \$788,000, which was \$188,000 over our goal. Our Auction's Fund-A-Need, directed towards financial aid and faculty support, set a new record by raising \$342,000.

The Board welcomed four new trustees during 2021 – 2022: Kim Baker, Jim Gellas, Suzanne Kim Tomlinson, and Vivian Lovett. As we look ahead to the next year, The Carey School is fortunate to be in a position of stability – admissions demand has grown, our program continues to inspire a love of learning, and our financial health is strong.

The Carey community continues to be extremely supportive of the Carey School and the 2021-2022 school year was another successful fundraising year for Carey. Development is crucial to The Carey School and we are so appreciative of our entire community's generosity this past year.

Carey's Annual Fund raised \$788,000. This Fund continues to support all the things that make Carey unique which tuition alone does not cover, including professional development for our educators, special school programs, and other operational needs.

The Carey School Parents Association (CSPA) hosted our auction in-person after two years on zoom and Fund-A-Need raised \$342,000 to support financial aid. This tremendous support speaks to the importance and value our community places in ensuring Carey remains a diverse and inclusive community welcoming of all students regardless of financial means.

Finally, we had the second year of a 5th grade gift with funds being donated to the Duncan Lyon Faculty Endowment Fund. The graduating fifth grade class raised \$71,000 for this initiative. We are grateful to all the families for contributing to this important cause.

Our essential fundraising would not have been possible without the hard work and dedication of the development committee members, board members, CSPA volunteers, and donors throughout the Carey community. We are also grateful for the support of the staff, teachers, and parents who pitch in everyday to ensure Carey sustains its mission of creating curious, confident, and joyful learners. We look forward to another exciting year ahead.

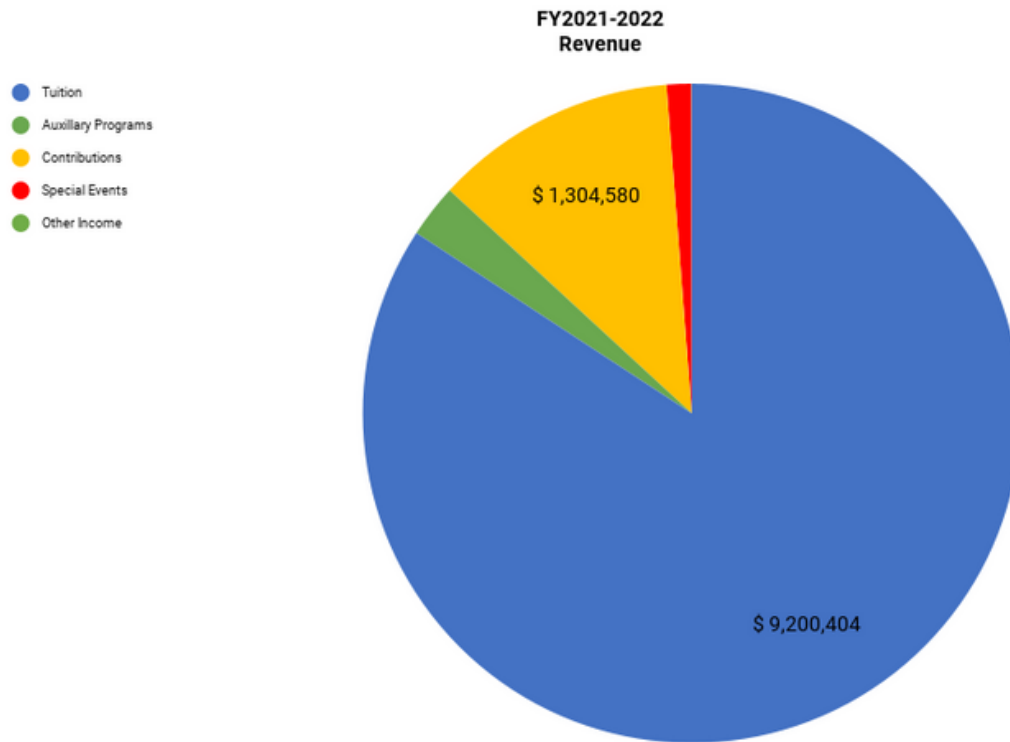

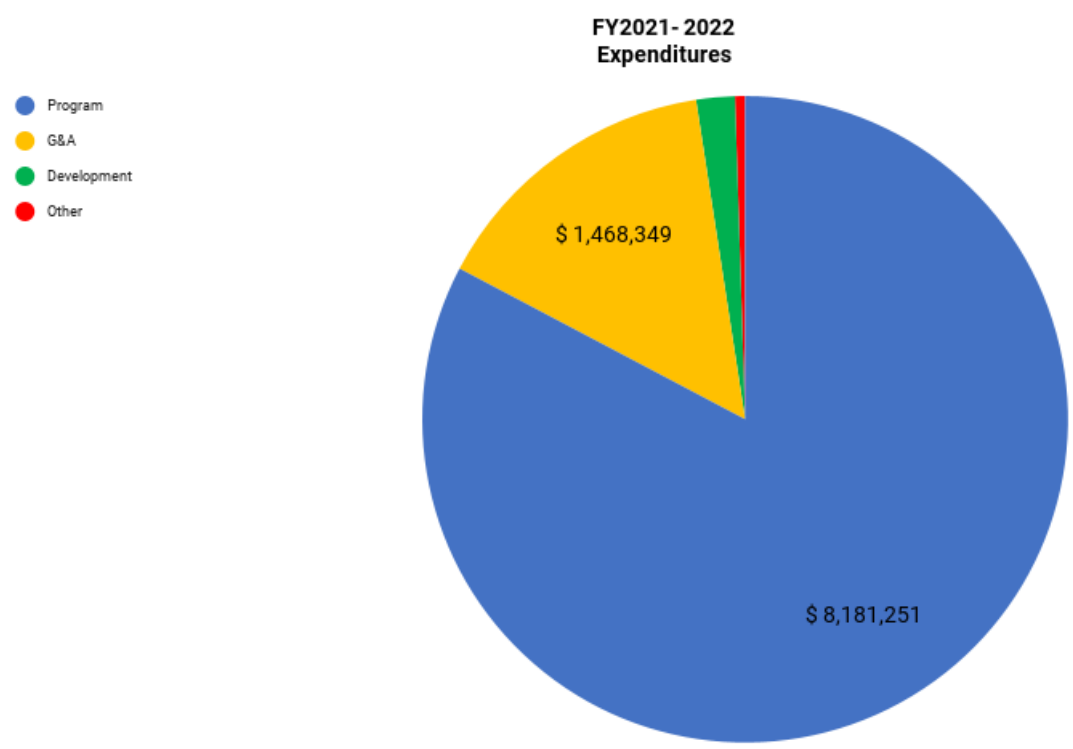
