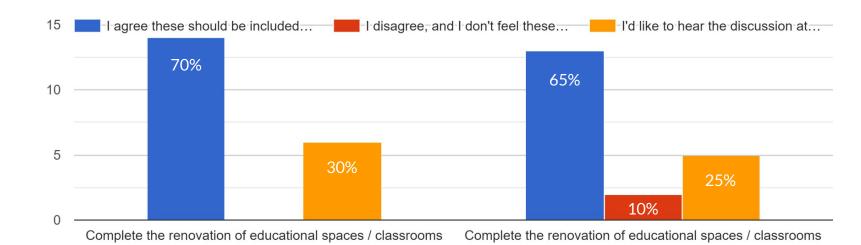

at Blalack and Long Middle Schools.

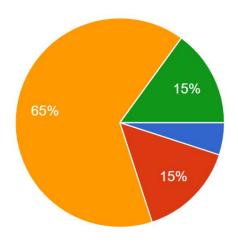

### Fiber and Critical Technology Infrastructure

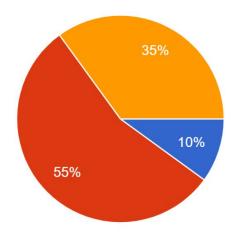

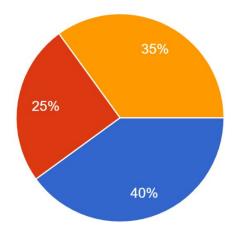


- Since almost everyone voted for at least one of the options, include option 1 which was \$5 million.

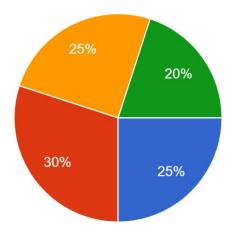


- Only the Early Childhood projects that reached 75% consensus should be included in our recommendation. (These were for the "OLD" and "OLD-ish" ele...

### **Bond Amount**

Which best describes your opinion about the overall bond amount that the committee should recommend?

- Stay under \$719 million so there is no impact to the I&S tax rate.
  - Somewhere between \$720 and \$740 million so there is no more than a half cent increase to the I&S tax rate.
  - Somewhere between \$740 and \$765 million so there is no more than a one cent increase to the I&S tax rate.

# Discussion, Voting & Build-A-Bond



### **REMINDER...Definitions**

- LIGHT Indicates a very strategic refresh. Does not include all finishes.
- REFRESH Indicates a finish refresh to walls, floors and ceiling.
- RENOVATION Indicates a more significant scope. May involve relocation of walls, alteration to room size, location, finishes as well as update of building systems.

Including varying perspectives from the entire community is very important to the process.



#### **COMMITTEE CHARGE**

To help the district plan for the future, the Citizens' Committee is charged to:

- Represent the entire community in the facility planning process
- Assist the district in assessing and prioritizing the District's current and long-term facility needs, including, but not limited to:
  - o Operational efficiency
  - Building age, safety and condition
  - Student and program equity, including early literacy
  - Evolving educational delivery and programs

#### **COMMITTEE CHARGE**

- Consider the educational needs of all students and align recommendations with the district's mission, vision and goals
- Consider the district's current financial position and funding methods to develop a recommendation that is fiscally sound
- Report their findings to the Carrollton-Farmers Branch ISD Board of Trustees that will include recommendations on how to proceed with a long-range facilities plan

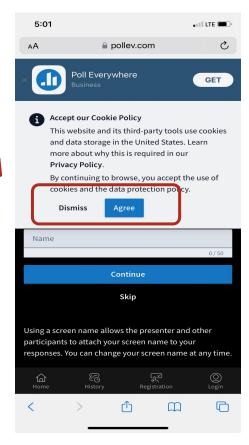

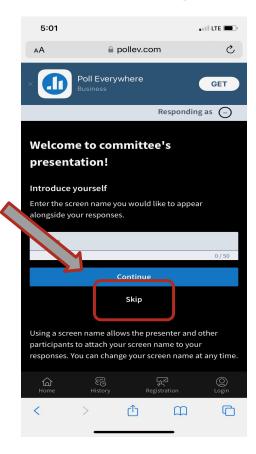
