The meeting was called to order at 9:20 a.m. at the Las Virgenes Unified School District, 4111 Las Virgenes Road, Calabasas, CA.

### Gold Award Project

AHS student, Savannah Rangel presented a Gold Award Project that she would like to complete at AE Wright Middle School. Ms. Rangel explained that as a Girl Scout, a Gold Award Project is the most prestigious project one can complete. She shared that she would like to paint positive messages on the stalls in the girl's restroom. She would buy the paint and stencils and would complete the work over summer break. Ms. Rangel spoke of the importance of positive messages.
