A student who qualifies according to the following criteria and continues an education at a Missouri Public community college or vocational-technical school can be eligible for state reimbursed tuition, general fees, cost subject to legislative approval for up to two years. The A+ program may provide these educational incentives provided state funds are appropriated by the legislature and approved. Each student should enter into a written agreement with the school during the last three years prior to high school graduation and to be eligible, must have:

1. Attended an A+ school for three consecutive years prior to high school graduation.
2. Graduated from high school with a GPA of 2.5 or greater on a 4.0 scale.
3. Maintained at least a 95% attendance record for the four-year period.
4. Performed 50 hours of unpaid tutoring or mentoring for other students. (complete semester, minimum)
5. Attained a score of Advanced or Proficient on the Algebra I (or higher) EOC exam; or a qualifying score on any of the following: ACT math subtest, COMPASS Pre-Algebra, or COMPASS Algebra.
6. Maintained a record of good citizenship in accordance with the A+ citizenship agreement.
7. Made a documented, good faith effort to secure all available federal post-secondary student financial assistance funds that do not require payment.

The student financial incentive will be available for a period of four years after high school graduation. To maintain eligibility during that time, each eligible student must enroll and attend a Missouri public community college or vocational-technical school on a full-time basis and maintain a GPA of 2.5 or higher.
