Health Office Checklist



Welcome to the Mount Pleasant School District!

The following **Health Forms** will be required upon entering **as a new student**.

*******MANDATORY FORMS*******

- 1. NYS School Health Examination Form completed by a NYS Health Provider. NYS School Health Examination Form is required and should be dated within 12 months prior to the first day of school.**

- 2. Immunization Record completed by a NYS Health Provider**

- 3. Student Health History Update**
To be completed by the parent/guardian for all students. This will give the nurse the most up-to-date health information for each student.

*******REQUESTED FORMS*******

- 1. Dental Certificate - Requested**

- 2. Medication Authorization Form - (If applicable, this form is required)**
Completed by parent and physician if your child requires medication in school (**daily or as needed**). This includes over-the-counter medications such as Tylenol, Motrin, Benadryl and/or cough drops. Parents/Guardian must deliver medication to the Health Office.

- 3. Allergy Action Medication Plan - (If applicable, this form is required)**
