A Private, Catholic High School Can Be Affordable. Even Free.

Tuition to attend Franciscan High School for the 2023-2024 school year is \$13,500. An annual \$40 registration fee is due when your child registers for the upcoming school year. Below are options for available financial aid to significantly decrease the cost of tuition, down to \$0.00 for qualifying families.

Louisiana Scholarship Program

The Louisiana Scholarship Program (LSP), also known as voucher scholarships, are distributed by the State of Louisiana via an application and lottery system each year. Eligible families who meet certain income, residency, and prior school requirements must apply online between December 12, 2022 and January 27, 2023, to be entered into a lottery for a voucher scholarship. If your child is currently using a LSP scholarship at their current school, you must reapply for the scholarship to enter high school. Determinations on LSP scholarship awards are made by the State of Louisiana in April 2023.

Students who receive a LSP Scholarships pay \$0 in tuition and fees to attend FHS.

School Tuition Organization Scholarship

Non-profit organizations in Louisiana, known as School Tuition Organizations, are able to issue scholarships to families who qualify based on income and residency. These scholarships cover \$4,500 of the cost of tuition for each scholarship recipient. Families who receive STO scholarships must renew them annually with their STO.

Students who receive a STO Scholarship pay \$500 in tuition per year plus a \$40 registration fee to attend FHS.

Private Tuition Students

Students who are not eligible for the Louisiana State Scholarship or a School Tuition Organization Scholarship **pay a discounted tuition of \$4,500 per year plus a \$40 registration fee.** Tuition payments can be spread out over 10 months through the FHS Finance Department.

Is my family eligible for a scholarship?

1 Income Eligibility

Your family's household income, based on your household size, cannot exceed the thresholds listed here.

2 Prior School Eligibility

Incoming students to Franciscan High School must currently have a Louisiana Scholarship Program or School Tuition Organization scholarship OR be previously enrolled in a Louisiana public or charter school in the preceding school year.

NOTE: Students applying for a Louisiana Scholarship Program scholarship for the first time must have previously attended a Louisiana public or charter school.

3 Applications

Both scholarship programs require families to apply and provide necessary documentation to verify income and residency in order to be eligible for financial aid. Parents are responsible for providing these documents and ensuring their child's scholarship is renewed.

Other Scholarship Notes

Does your child already have a Louisiana Scholarship Program scholarship at their current school?

Great! To move your scholarship to Franciscan, parents must submit an application that lists their preferred school choices (Franciscan High School) for the next school year. Parents do not need to resubmit eligibility documentation and will automatically be deemed eligible. Your child also will receive priority in the lottery process but are not guaranteed a new scholarship seat.

My child has a School Tuition Scholarship at their current school. What do I need to do to bring that scholarship to Franciscan High?

If your child already has an STO scholarship from ACE Scholarships, Arete or San Damiano Scholars, parents must re-apply for the scholarship each year with their STO. You will have to resubmit your income and residency documentation and choose Franciscan High as your school of choice. Most STO scholarships give priority to students who were awarded a scholarship in the prior year.
