Ms. Poland welcomed the group and thanked everyone for being there. A motion to approve the minutes from the September PTO Meeting was moved and seconded. The minutes were approved without objection.

Principal's Report: Elton Armbrister

Mr. Armbrister explained that there is no update on the cafeteria project but that hopefully it can be finished between semesters this winter. He said that he appreciates all of the support during Warrior Dash and that it was a fun event. Mr. Armbrister brought up details about the House Bill 2567 that went into effect last summer.
