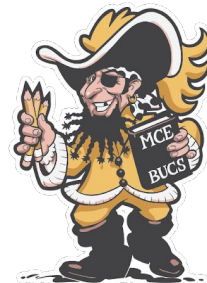
Reporting Absences

Updates to MVCSC Quarantine Guidelines

MVCSC sent out a message earlier in the week about new updates regarding quarantine guidelines.

[HERE](#) is a link to the FAQ page that has the most up to date information.

Two of the biggest changes are listed below.

- Students exposed to a COVID positive student while at lunch will be contact traced. A Parentsquare Alert will be sent as notification to parents/guardians. Additional self-monitoring for symptoms and optional (parent choice) quarantine information is simultaneously sent via email. In most situations, we expect that **No quarantine will be required.**
- Positive or Negative Results - For the test to be accepted by health services:
 - At-Home Tests: A photo of the at-home test with the child's name and test date physically written on the test must be emailed to the health clinic within 24 hours of testing. This applies for negative results as well as positive for the student/staff. Health services must be able to clearly see that the image is/has not been reused.
 - Facility Test Results: Test results from facilities must have the child's name and the test date on the printed report within 24 hours of receiving test results.

Under current USDA waivers, all complete student meals are free of charge. Additional entrees or a la carte items are an additional cost, charging is not allowed on these items, students must have sufficient funds to purchase.
