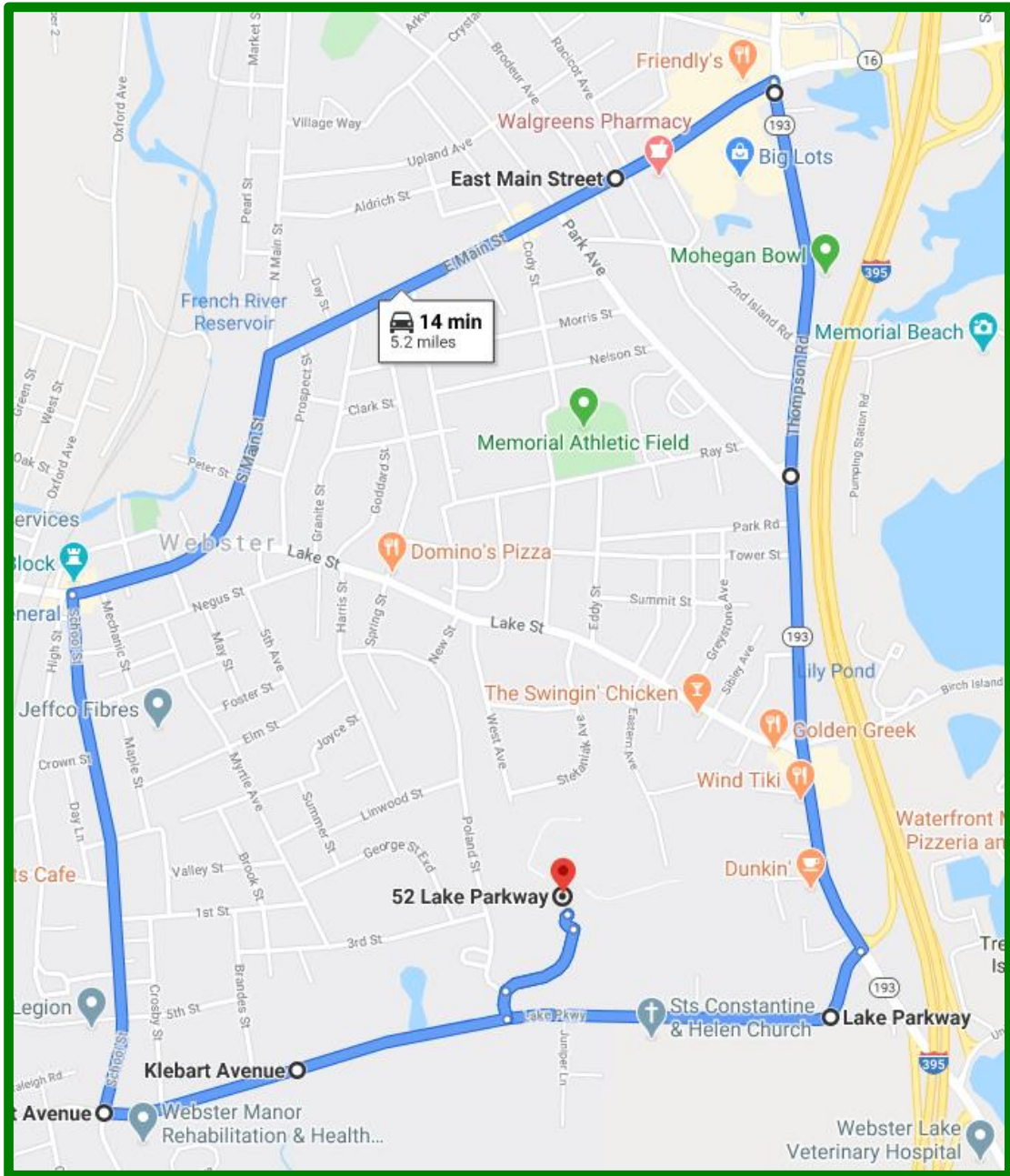
Buses carrying the seniors will be leaving BHS at noon on Friday, June 5.

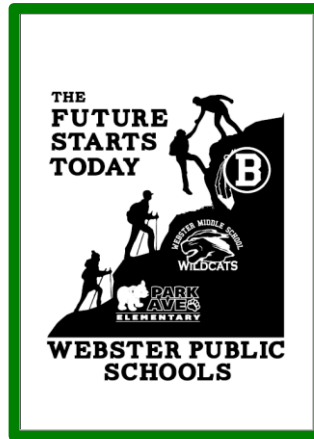


Below is a map of the route:
