6. Ken Shaughnessy from National Grid donated 20 Yoobi Boxes of school supplies to PAE this week!

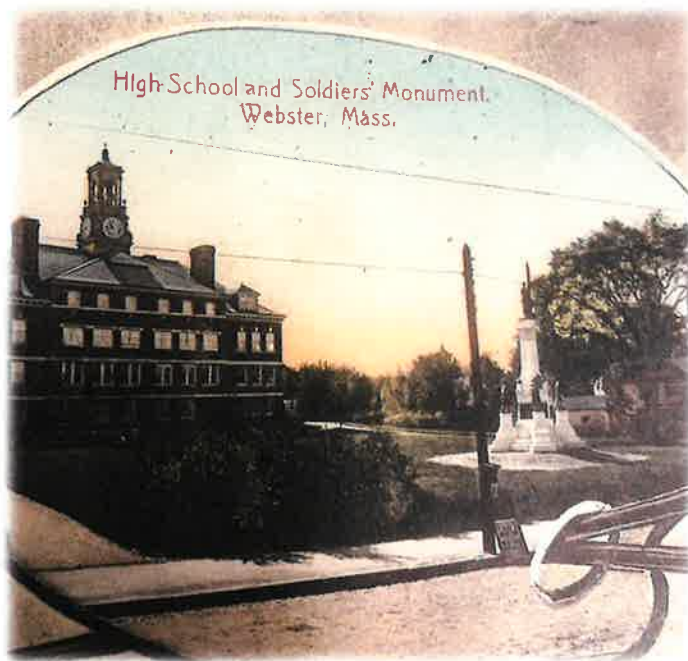
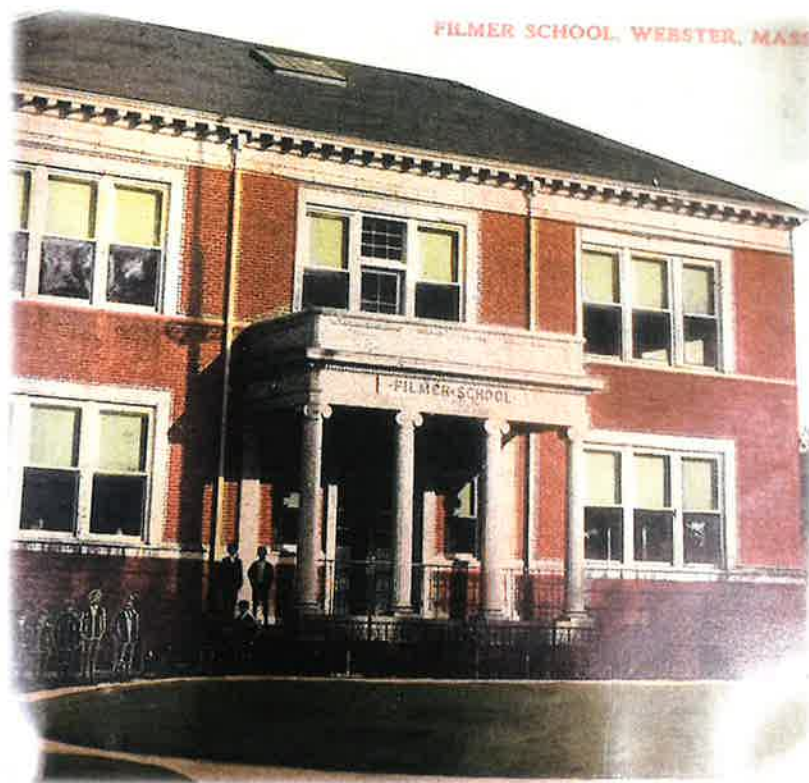

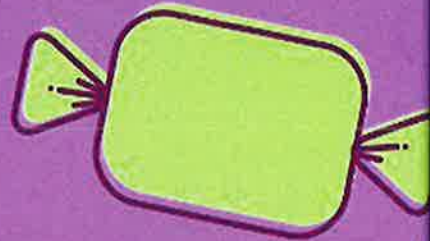
