To support the learning and development or our students, we have worked diligently this year to review and update our curriculum resources for our teachers and staff. The following is a short list of some of the changes that have occurred in our academic programming and schools:

- We increased the time on learning at PAE and WMS by 32 hours a month
- We piloted a new researched based reading program PreK-5 and purchased it
- We received the Strategic Support to Specific Underperforming Schools Grant for PAE- this is focused on strategies to improve student achievement outcomes
- We updated the report cards at PAE and WMS
- We started a new athletic program for WMS
- WMS began PBIS training
- We trained all staff in A.L.I.C.E. safety preparedness
- We added new Title 1 afterschool programs at WMS and BHS
- We graduated our 1st Nichols Academy Cohort at BHS
- We produced a new Program of Studies at BHS
- We celebrated the Class of 2018 at BHS with 83% of our student going off to college
- We reviewed our Math curriculum and will be purchasing a new program while providing our teachers and staff ongoing professional development
- We reviewed our Science curriculum and will be implementing standards based new hands-on learning activities
- New teacher instructional leadership teams at WMS and PAE
