The scholarship covers tuition as long as students maintain a 3.0 GPA and complete an annual FAFSA. Students earn this scholarship by scoring Advanced and Proficient on their grade 10 MCAS and being in the top 25% with their results. With college costs rising, this is a tremendous opportunity for our students.


