WHEN: WEDNESDAY, JUNE 7, 2023 (buses begin loading at 10:00 a.m.)

<u>COST:</u> \$260.00 per person (Exact amount and <u>CASH ONLY!)</u>

Your ticket is being sold to you on "**Good Faith**". On June 7, if you owe any money to the school or have any detentions, you **WILL NOT** go to Disneyland and there are **NO REFUNDS**.

SALES: Monday, March 6 through Friday, March 10 at lunch and after school at the

Student Store. Ticket quantities are limited.

HOW: Transportation from GHC to and from Disneyland will be by **BUS ONLY**.

To get on a bus, all students must show their PHOTO I.D. and Boarding Pass, and must be

on our list.

Buses will arrive at Granada for boarding on Wednesday, June 7 at 10:00 a.m. and return to school at approximately 3:30 a.m. Thursday morning, June 8. You must

arrange your own ride to and from school. It is highly recommended that students do not

drive themselves to and from GHC.

<u>IMPORTANT – To purchase a ticket at the Student Store, each senior must have:</u>

1. Current GHC I.D.

2. One completed and signed trip slip

3. Cash Only - \$260 for each BOARDING PASS/TICKET (exact amount, please)

If you wish to sit on a bus with your friends, you <u>must</u> buy <u>all</u> the tickets at the same time as tickets are sold by bus number. When you come to the window to buy the tickets, <u>please let the seller know how many tickets you are buying</u> <u>as a group to ensure you are on the same bus</u>. If a bus has fewer seats available than you need, we can then open the next bus for your group. Students are assigned to a particular bus, but there are no assigned seats on the bus.

You MUST comply with any COVID rules in force at the time of Grad Nite, as set forth on Disneyland's website or as may be set by the school or PTSA. Masks are required while on the bus, and other requirements may be in effect at that time, including possible testing and/or vaccination requirements.

NOTE: Tickets to Grad Nite were <u>NOT</u> sold in any senior package or at any time previously and Disneyland Annual Passports cannot be used for this special event.

BOARDING PASSES ARE NON-TRANSFERABLE (You may not sell - or give away your pass)
You will receive your actual Grad Nite ticket as you exit the bus at Disneyland. If you lose your ticket at Disneyland, there are no replacements and Disneyland will require you purchase a new one.

GRAD NITE 2023 FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- 1. **How much are tickets?** \$260 Cash only exact amount, please.
- 2. When do we leave for Disneyland? Buses will begin loading at 10:00 a.m. and depart once the bus is loaded. Line up with the group that matches your boarding ticket bus number. There is no assigned seating on the bus and no switching buses. Buses will return Thursday morning at approximately 3:30 a.m.
- 3. Why do I need a trip slip? Legally, the PTSA needs a trip slip from every person in case of any injuries or emergencies that may occur. No Trip Slip, no Grad Nite ticket!
- 4. What if I'm 18? You will sign your own trip slip instead of having your parent/guardian sign it.
- 5. **Do I need to bring my student I.D.?** YES, you will need it when buying your Grad Nite ticket AND for getting on the bus the day of Grad Nite.
- 6. What is the last day to buy tickets? Tickets will be sold March 6 through March 10. If any tickets are available after that, the Student Store will make them available for purchase. Tickets are limited so don't wait. Buy early!
- 7. What can I bring with me? Disney will do a search at the gate prior to entering to check for any items not allowed in the park. You may bring cell phones, cameras, jackets, sunscreen, etc. No large backpacks, please. You may also rent lockers at the park, but they go fast so there are no guarantees. Spending money for meals and souvenirs is recommended. Meals are NOT included in your ticket price. Outside food and beverages are not allowed in the park. You may bring an EMPTY metal or plastic water bottle that can be refilled in the park.
- 8. What if I have medicine I need to take? Personal medications are allowed, but MUST be in their original, labeled container and MUST be listed on your trip slip when purchasing your ticket. Even if you intend to bring something like Advil or Tylenol, list it on the slip. If you don't absolutely need it, leave it at home.
- 9. When do I get my actual ticket to Disneyland? As you exit the bus, each person will be given their park hopper pass. When you get your ticket, immediately place it in a safe place. You need it each time you park hop. If your ticket is lost, it will NOT be replaced, and Disneyland will require you to purchase a new ticket.
- 10. <u>Can I buy tickets from someone else?</u> NO. The tickets must be GRAD NITE tickets and must be purchased from the PTSA. The name on the current GHC I.D. must match the person on the trip slip and boarding pass. We check this as you board the bus. Disneyland Annual Passports cannot be used for this event.
- 11. <u>Do school rules apply at Disneyland?</u> YES!! This is a PTSA event and the same rules apply and will be enforced. There are also a lot of undercover officers and you will be arrested if you are caught doing anything illegal. If you appear drunk or high as you get on the bus, or are suspected of having illegal substances, we will call school staff and they will evaluate the situation and deny or OK you to board. Don't ruin your Grad Nite by doing something foolish.
- 12. <u>Can I just drive to Disneyland and meet everyone there?</u> NO. Disneyland requires that attendees arrive via school-provided transportation. If you do not travel on one of our buses, you will not be given your ticket to enter. Special wristbands are given to each person at Disneyland after you pass through the security check and without that, you cannot get into Disneyland.
- 13. What if I have only a few detentions I didn't get around to working off? Simply put YOU DO NOT GO and there are NO REFUNDS. We make it clear on all our forms and in announcements that everyone must have zero detention hours and zero money owed to the school or YOU DO NOT GO! Also, if for any reason the school says you are not allowed to attend Grad Nite, we will not let you board the bus and you will not receive a refund.
- 14. What are the rules and dress code for Grad Nite? Remember this is a family park and the general public will be there throughout the day. We want you to have fun, but we also want you to represent the Class of 2023 and GHC in a positive way. Please visit the Disneyland website for precise information on their rules and dress code.
