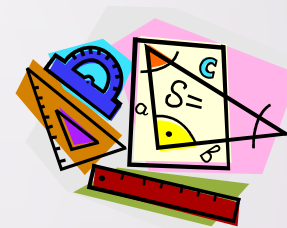

ADVANCED COURSES

- Good idea to challenge yourself with advanced classes, but think very carefully about these yearlong commitments
 - **Talk to your current teachers!**
- Pay attention to homework requirements
 - example: World Language recommends you spend 45 minutes a night to properly prepare for the class
- Evaluate your other commitments
 - clubs, athletics, family, work, volunteering, spiritual, etc.



COURSE SELECTION

Counselors will be returning next week to help you enter your course requests into skyward. Please spend this week talking with your parents, looking over the course catalog, and filling out the registration form.

REMINDERS!

- Think very carefully about course selections.
- It is very difficult to adjust schedules in the fall because any class changes are subject to space availability.



FALL SCHEDULE ADJUSTMENT PROCESS

- Students receive final schedules the week before school begins
- Follow schedule for first 2 days of school
 - If students have “See Counselor,” are missing a period, or have two classes scheduled at the same time, they need to come to the Counseling Center to select a class
- At end of second day, students may pick up or download a Schedule Adjustment Request form and follow the directions on the form
- If necessary, counselors will balance classes at beginning of the second week of the semester

March 1st: Registration requests entered for Kirkland Middle

- Counselors will be present at both schools on these dates to help with registration in skyward.



4-YEAR COURSE PLANNER IN XELLO

- In Xello you will find a downloadable course planner which you can use to map out the classes you will take during your 4 years of High School
- Planning ahead for your future classes will help to make sure you are completing the correct course sequence to get into higher level classes down the road (Example: making sure you take Chemistry before AP Chemistry)
- It will also help you to make sure you are meeting the subject and credit requirements for graduation
