The Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI) requires the Highline School District's Board of Directors to adopt a resolution certifying that the construction of the Tye High School Replacement Project at the current site will not create or aggravate racial imbalance in accordance with WAC 392-342-025.

III. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Tye High School Replacement project will be constructed at the same site current school. Since a portion of the funding for the construction of the replacement will be provided by OSPI's School Construction Assistance Program (SCAP), OSPI requires the School Board to adopt a resolution certifying that the construction of this project will not create or aggravate racial imbalance in accordance with WAC 392-342-025

Providing this resolution is required by the OSPI's Form D-5, Application for Preliminary Funding Status.
