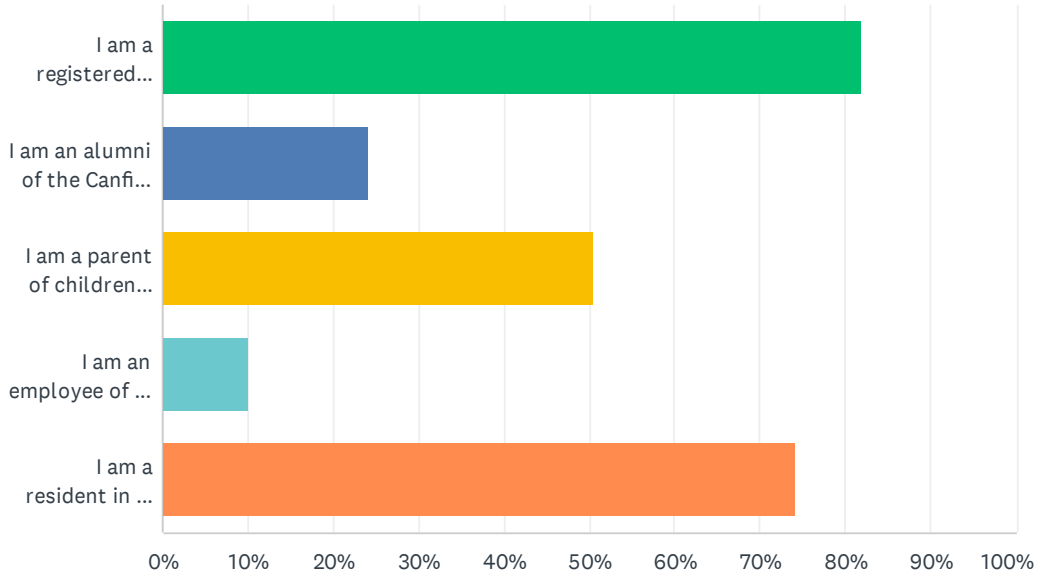


Q1 Please tell us your current affiliation with the Canfield Local School District. Select all that apply.

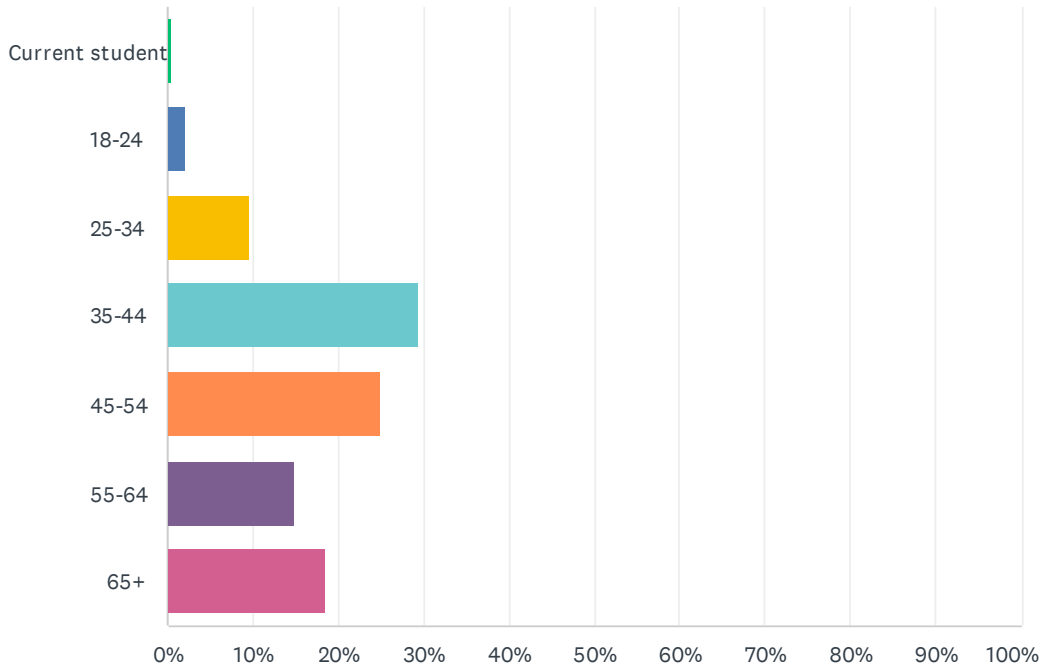

Q2 Which age bracket do you belong

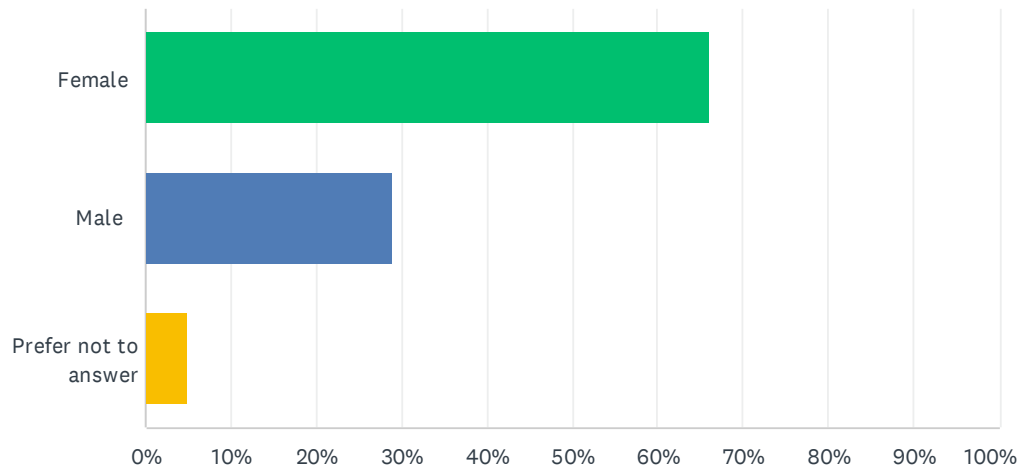

Q3 What is your gender?

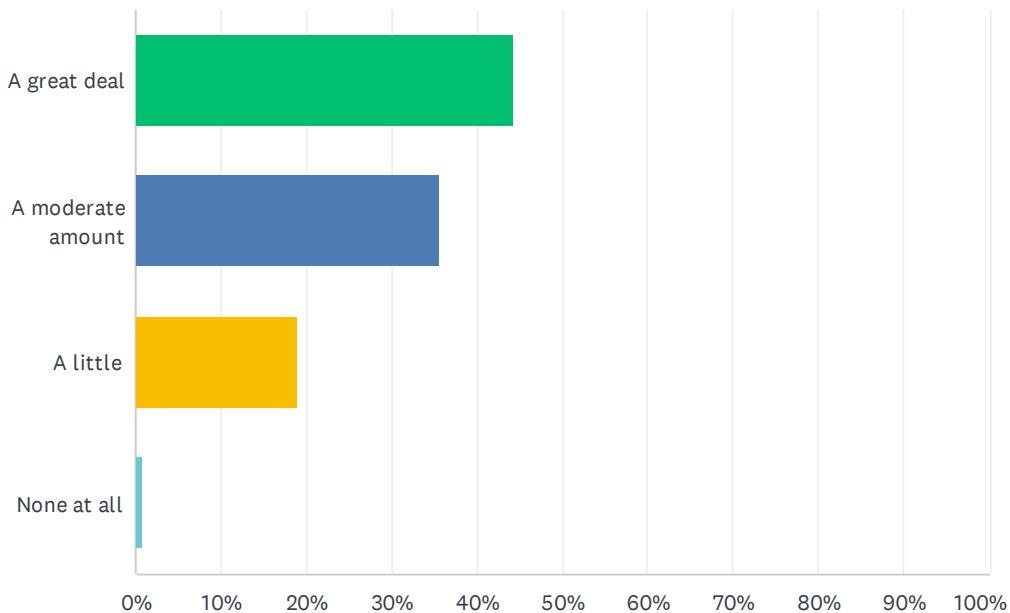

Q4 The Canfield Local School District recently placed a bond levy on the May 2022 ballot for a new elementary/middle building project. How much news or information did you hear about it?

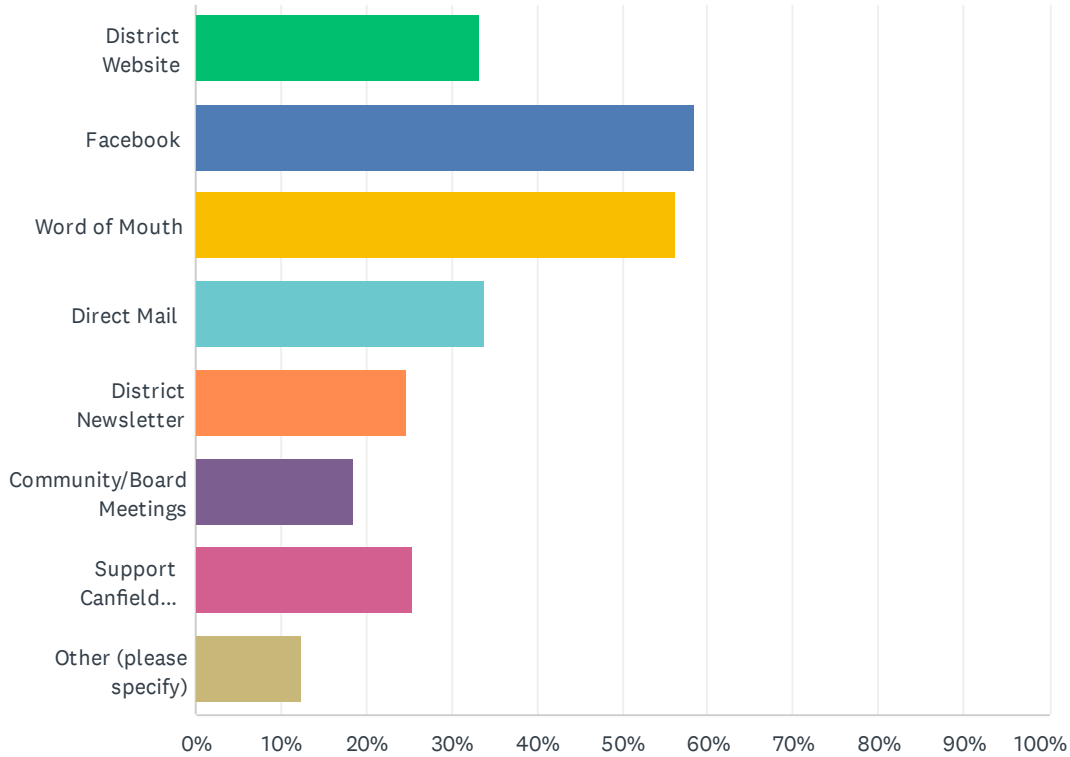

Q5 Where did you receive most of your information about the recent bond levy? Select all that apply.

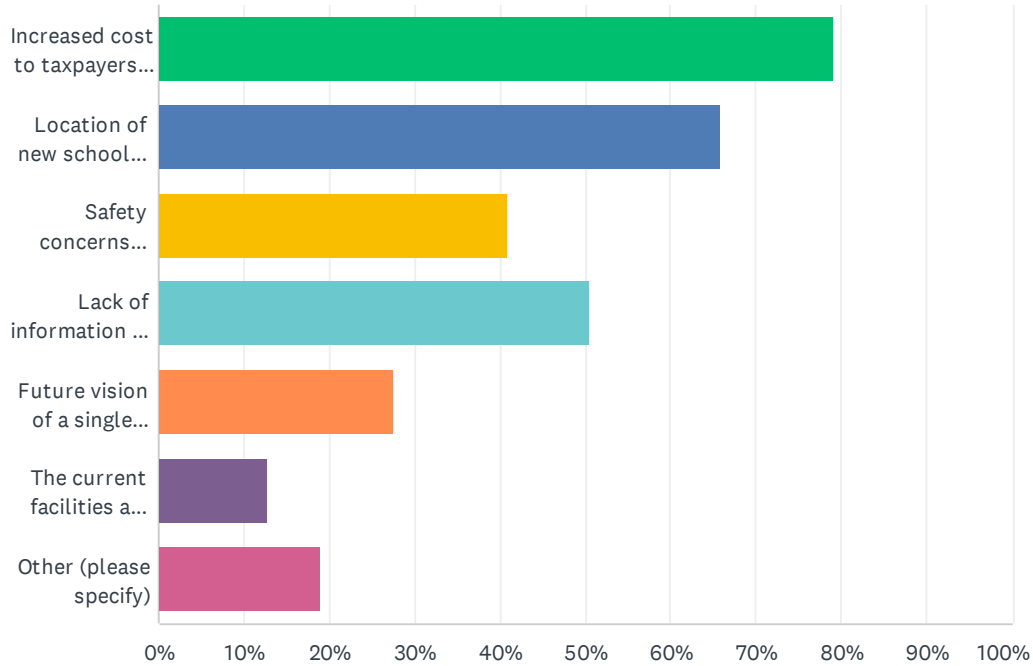

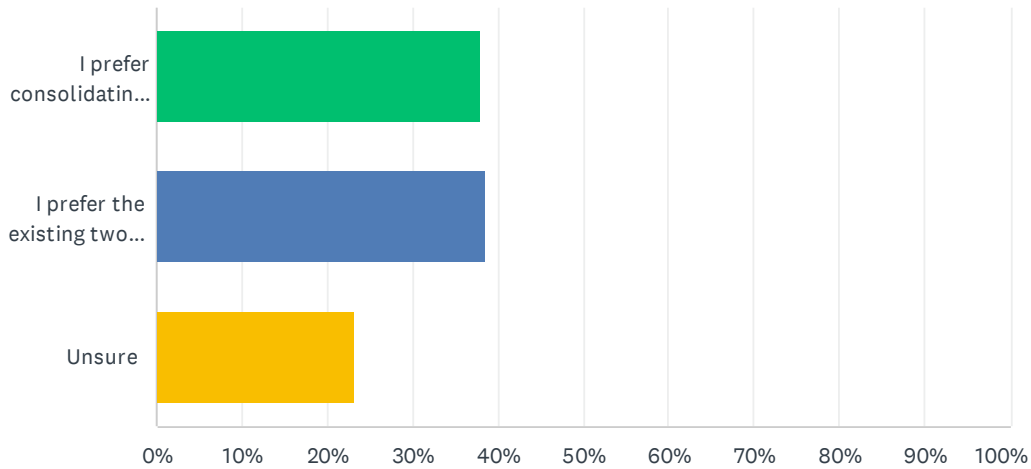

Q7 In general, do you support consolidating the existing two elementary and middle school buildings or do you prefer them as separate buildings as they currently are?

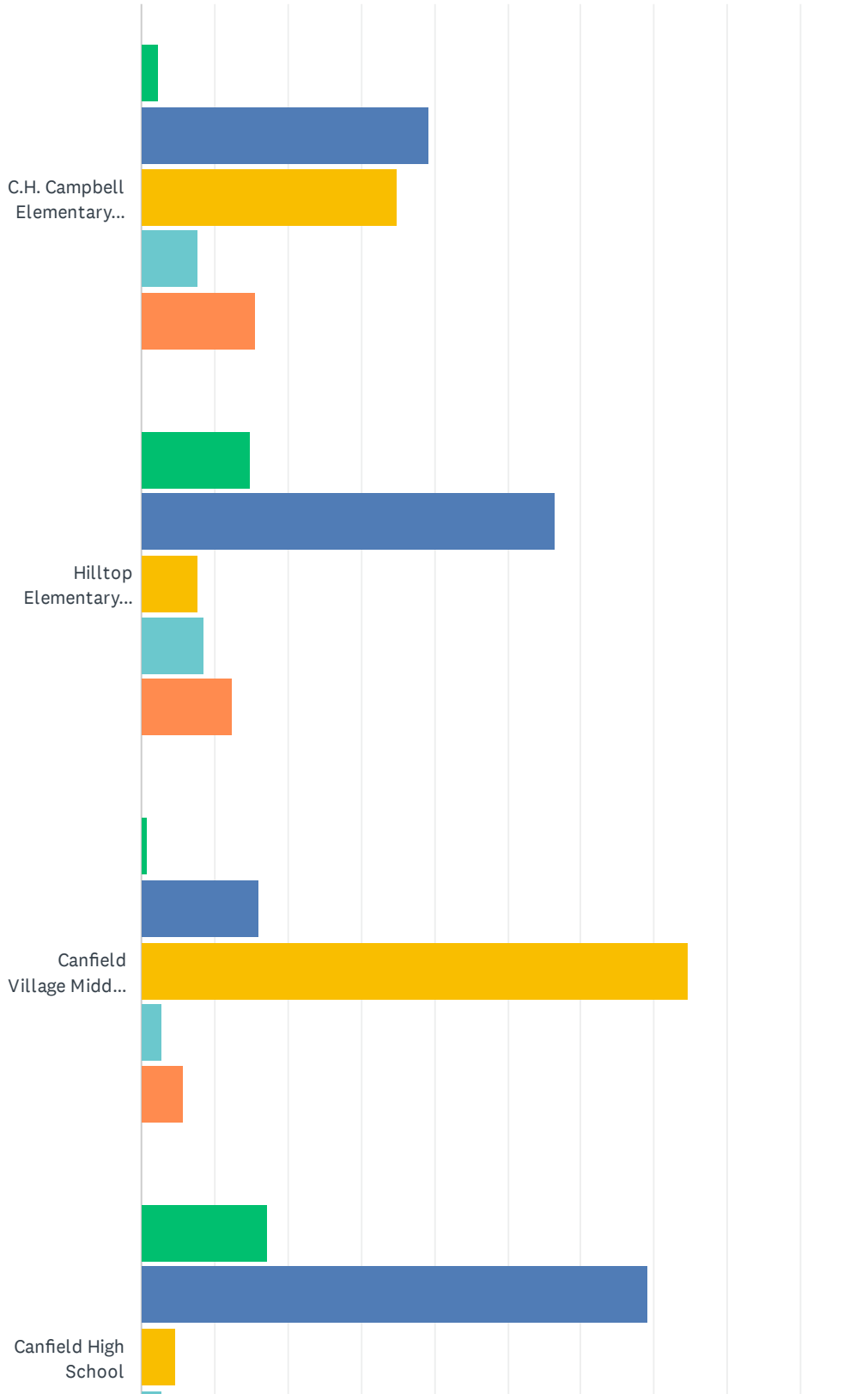

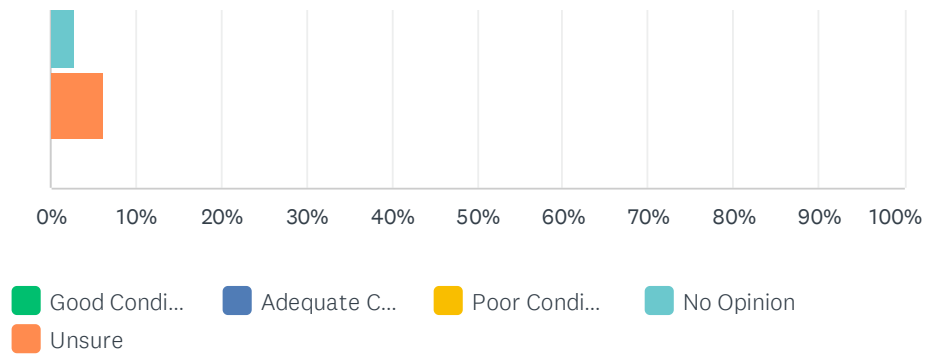

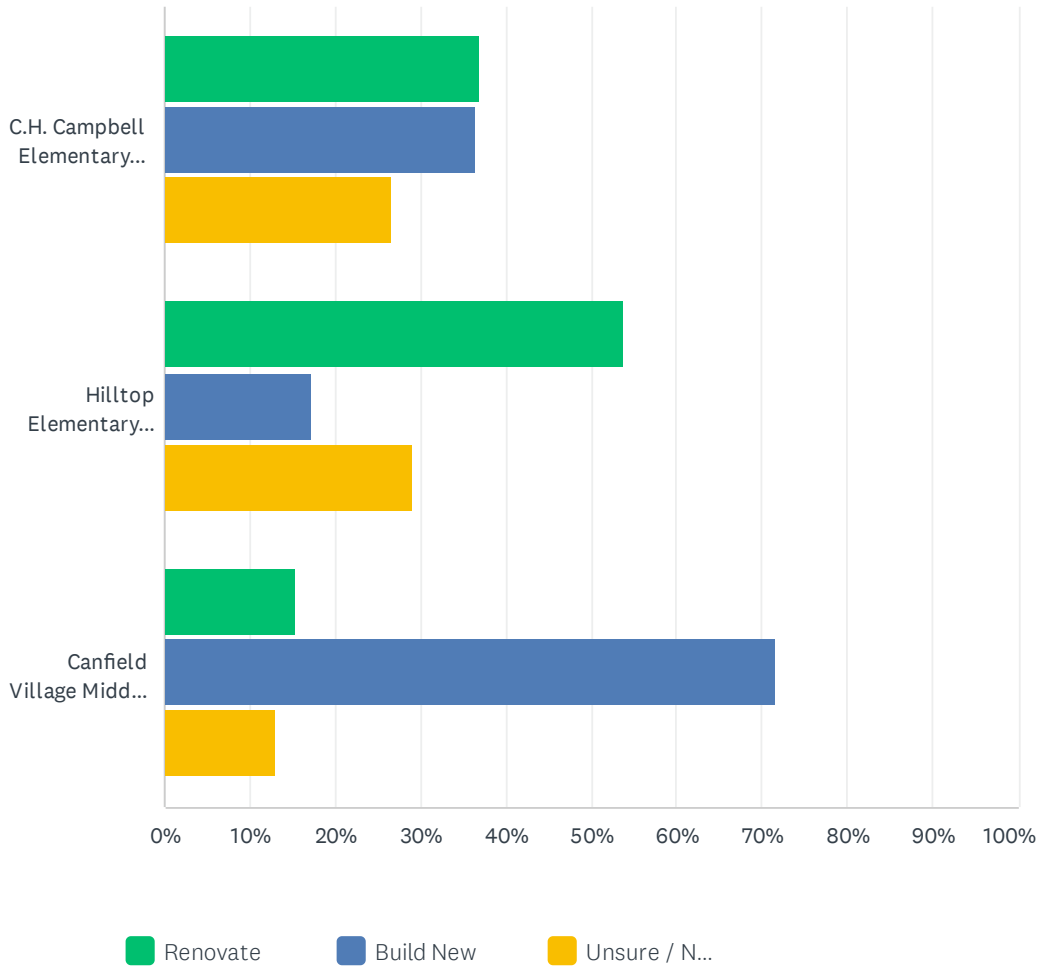

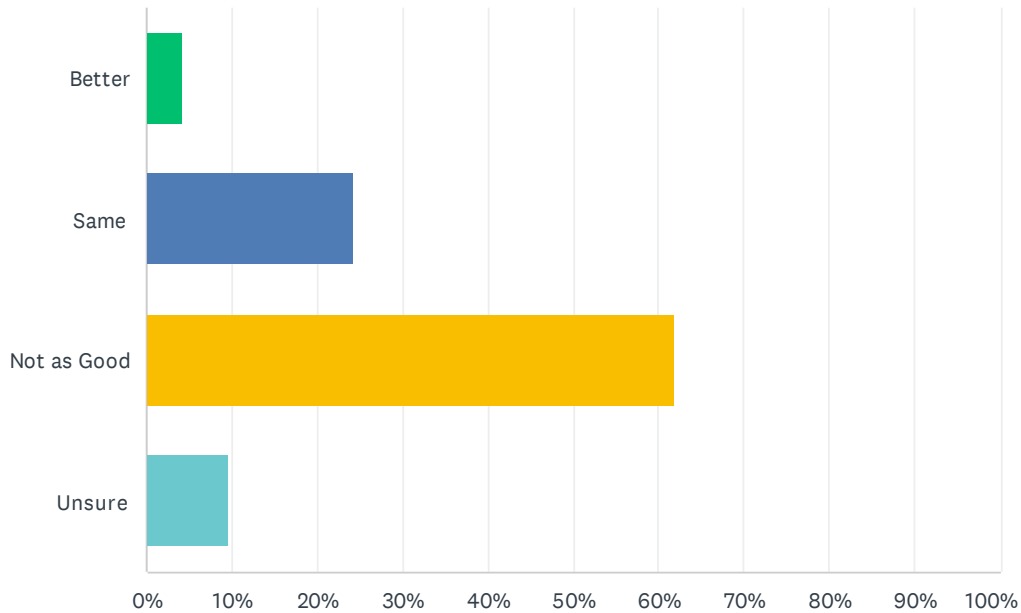

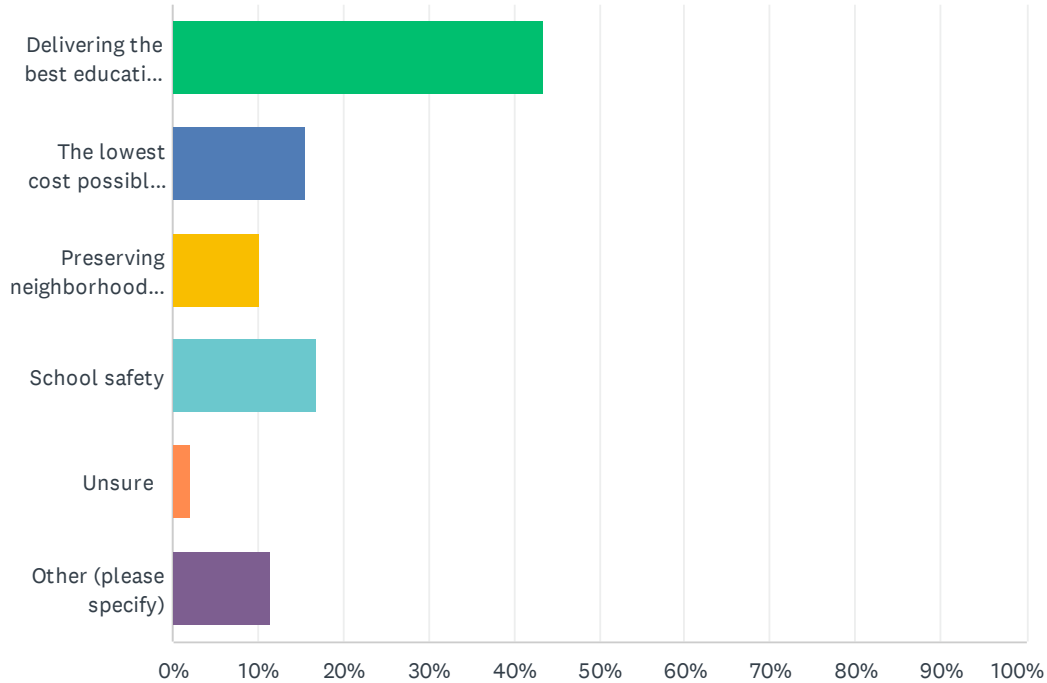
