January meeting minutes approved unanimously Open Board positions for 2023-24 school year have all been filled! President = Devin Insley / Spirit Nights = Jill Verser / Spirit Wear = Jennifer Ward Helping Hands Slowing down due to an attempt to reduce the amount of paper being used for copies PTO will take a break from Helping Hands volunteers until further notice. PES Administration will let Elizabeth know if there is a project where Helping Hands volunteers can be used. Bobbi to remove the Helping Hands signup sent out on 2/1 Playground – are there plans to upgrade or move to the back of the school? Mrs. Lamm reported there are currently no plans to move or upgrade the playground Discussed the aging playground and desire for enhancement / replacement Mrs. Lamm will investigate how playground replacements are funded - are school funds available? How would a purchase work? Is there an estimate of cost? Discussed a Gaga Pit that was thought to have been purchased prior to COVID shut-downs. Mrs. Lamm to investigate if there is a Gaga Pit available to install at PES

Skate Night?

This would not be a fundraiser, but a school-wide social event. There is a roller skating rink set up at Dare Elementary with roller skates available to rent. Elizabeth will investigate more details so a date can be set at the next PTO meeting.

Plan to purchase a quantity of various sizes and sell at Color Run, Spirit Nights, etc.

Fundraising and Spirit Nights, Jenny Defendeifer

The Fundraising Company (sneaker fundraiser)

- 111 shoes have been collected in recent months (primarily at Bean's Spirit Night) which brings the total collected up to approx. 250 pairs of shoes
- We will really push the shoe fundraiser this Spring to attempt to reach the goal of 700 shoes so we can submit the shoes and close out the fundraiser

"Can you spare 1 pair" - suggestion to really publicize the need for each student to donate just 1 pair of shoes to help us meet our goal

Color Run (School-A-Thon is the fundraising company that will lead the event)

First choice for location is the field in front of Kids Island. Jenny to coordinate with Poquoson Parks & Rec to secure field use

Electricity access is a requirement

April 15th is the tentative date for the Color Run from 4-6pm (3:30-4pm registration)

Kickoff would be 3/10, and fundraising envelopes / money will be due by 3/24

This is a rain or shine event

Consider having a DJ, photo booth or food truck options (Bean's Ice Cream Truck or Chick-Fil-A). Could sell waters for \$1 or have a table for spirit wear for extra fundraising

Will need a table setup for extra color powder sales at the event

To investigate first aid needs + requirement for a nurse on site

Be sure to advertise kids should bring a towel to sit on for the ride home and also consider having leaf blowers available on site to give families the option to blow powder off children before they depart

Spirit nights

Consider another Bean's Ice Cream Spirit Night for the Spring - Elizabeth to reach out to Bean's for possible dates in April or May

Jenny reported she is also considering a Poquoson Diner Spirit Night in the Spring
