■ **Course # 810** - What is “Summer Stretchers?” ~ for students currently in grades 1 & 2

This program is taught by Wausau School District staff and offers the opportunity for students to apply new knowledge and skills in an outdoor learning environment. Summer Stretchers offers unique experiences, challenges, games, and adventures; all in a secure world where new friends can be made, stories can be told, and campfires can be enjoyed. The afternoon activities include trips to local pools and parks, arts and crafts, playground fun and games, etc. Maximum enrollment is 50 students.

■ **Course # 820** - What is “Summer Saunters Ice Age Trail?” ~ for students currently in grades 3, 4, & 5

This program is taught by Wausau School District staff and designed to help students develop healthy lifestyles. Students will learn about Wisconsin’s great outdoors and history while using mathematics, social science, literacy and outdoor skills in real-life situations. Students are provided resources to locate and experience opportunities such as walking and hiking, while learning cultural, environmental and geographical qualities of Wisconsin. Students will hike different segments of the Ice Age Trail. Students must have positive attitudes and be willing to hike in various conditions including heat, insects and light rain. Maximum enrollment is 55 students.

■ **Course # 840** - What is “World Cultures?” ~ for students currently in grades 2, 3, & 4

This program provides a wonderful opportunity for students to learn about cultures from around the world. Each day students will “hop” on an imaginary jet and fly to a new country to explore the region and study the culture. Students make and sample food, study the language and experience what life is like in that part of the world. Maximum enrollment is 25 students. (Class availability pending on staffing.)
