| Have someone read to you for 20 minutes. | Have an adult say a word with a long vowel or short vowel. Tell the adult if the vowel says it's short or long sound. Do at least 10 words. (mat=short a, mate=long a) | Write 3 grade level appropriate sentences, including a detail about your favorite toys to play with. | Have an adult tell you a 2-digit number. Start at that number and keep counting on until they tell you to stop. Repeat process 5 times with a different start number. |
| Read to a pet, stuffed animal, or person for 20 minutes. | Write down as many sight words as you can. Look in a book if you can't think of any. Practice reading them to someone. | Would you rather build a snowman or a snow fort? Write or tell 3 reasons why. | Have an adult write a list of <u>addition</u> equations, including the answers. They should purposely make 5 incorrect. Your job is to find the 5 with mistakes! |
| Read a fiction book and draw a picture of your favorite part. Write to describe your picture. | Write words with l, r, and s blends (gl, pr, sp, scr etc.). Practice breaking up the words into individual sounds verbally. | Write a list of 10 things to do on a snow day. | Have an adult write a list of <u>subtraction</u> equations, including the answers. They should purposely make 5 incorrect. Your job is to find the 5 with mistakes! |
| Read a nonfiction book and draw a picture of a fact you learned. Write the fact you learned. | Write words with digraphs (sh, th, ch, wh, ph) Practice breaking up the words into individual sounds verbally. | Write the steps on how to do something. Use words first, next, then, last. | Use cards, dice, or an app to practice adding/subtracting for 10-15 minutes. |
| Read any book. Write or tell a review of the book. Did you like it? Why or why not. Try to give 2-3 reasons why. | Make 2 sentences using 1 short vowel and 1 long vowel word in each sentence.. | Write 3 facts about your favorite animal and draw a picture of it. | Count different coin combination amounts using pennies, nickels, dimes. Add in quarters if you choose. |
