Stephanie Stapleton – Welcome

TJ Strain motioned to start the meeting.

Reviewed Minutes – motioned to approve the minutes from last meeting – Rebecca Mann 1st, Nick Burst 2nd.

Tj Strain proposed that Terra Bingham to take notes and be on SCC as the secretary. Stephanie Stapleton 2nd.

Rachel Wallin – (Orchestra Teacher) Explain how she used the grant money to build a better climate and curriculum for the Orchestra program. They made it to State!

Mrs. Peterson – (Theater Teacher) Explain how she used the grant money. Replacing equipment, workshop with professional actors, and going to see live production. Ben Bolliger (member of SCC) is wondering if we can use money next year for new audio. TJ Strain said more equipment are coming this year.

TJ Strain reached out to all department to see if they are still planning on using their funds. English department said that they will not be using theirs.

TSSP – Getting 155,477.00 next year with a role over around 5,000.00

Goal #1 – Last year 95.9% left with all core credit. (12 students didn't) Many interventions were done to assist those students. Proposed goal would be 97% of 9th grade students will leave with sufficient credit in all core areas.

Expenses – Student Success Coordinators (4 – 3.9 hour) They help out in Study Skills class and around the halls during passing time and lunch. We would also want some department requests in March. (\$15,000) A total of \$60,000.

Proposed Goal #2 – LJH will implement a Model of Instruction specifically focused on Content, Feedback, and Context of a lesson. (PD for teachers) Teach, Check, and Environment - Legacy will make a 10% improvement will be made in the following areas as measured by observation data.

Expenses – 8 full year productivity periods – 83,000, Teacher Collaboration for School year collaboration 12,000. Total for goal 95,000

Reallocation of Funds - \$25,000 – Some ideas: summer conference in summer 2023 (6 teachers \$15000) teachers to apply for mini-grants related to goals. (\$10,000) Will relook in March.

Summit Discussion – Next Tuesday the School Board will be reviewing and having a workshop. They are wondering if an opt in for students' option instead of whole school. TJ Strain presented Hattie Teacher Efficacy and Response to Intervention. Devan Roper (teacher) talked about the benefits of summit and the challenges that it would bring if we did an opt-in. (teacher collaboration, workload, and student experience no matter what they have.) Rebecca Mann, were emailed by other parents their concerns. (Is worried about teachers but feels that some students struggle in summit. Would like to

address the community concerns.) Rebecca Mann will send the concerns to Administration. TJ Strain encouraged parents would make an appointment to talk about to him.
