Minutes	Emma Pereida-Martinez asked all members to review and approve the Minutes from the March 16, 2022 meeting. They were distributed through mail to all DAC representatives prior to the meeting and presented on the PowerPoint during the meeting. A motion was made by Maria Garcia and seconded by Patricia Pantoja, and minutes were approved unanimously. There was no additional discussion nor were there further recommended changes or additions. Motion carried unanimously.
Public Comment	The floor was opened for public comment on items on the agenda. Mrs. Pereida-Martinez shared with attendees that like most districts across the country, Arvin Union School District is facing food and paper products shortages and delayed shipments. However, the district is making adjustments/modifications to the menu to ensure it all works out, so please be understanding of the situation and support the modifications being implemented, especially if students complain there is not a big variety on the menu. Attendees expressed their concern/comments on the following topics: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maria Garcia mentioned the water at Sierra Vista does not taste good according to her students. She would like school personnel to taste the water. Maria Venegas also expressed her concerns regarding the taste of the drinking water consumed by students. Mrs. Pereida-Martinez asked administrators if anyone of them have tasted the water. Mrs. Ocampo responded that she has tasted the water at El Camino Real and does not have any complaints. Mr. Salinas said he has not tasted the water at Bear Mountain and has not heard any complaints from students or parents.
Update of Water Fountains	Chris Davis, Chief Business Official shared maps of all school sites that shows the location of water fountains and water bottle refill stations at each site. Two more water bottle refill stations will be added to each site and new filters will be installed at the beginning of the school year.
Review of LCAP Input from DAC for 2022-2023	Emma Pereida-Martinez reviewed the LCAP the input that was shared at the DAC meeting in March. Mrs. Pereida-Martinez thanked everyone for their support. The Arvin Union School District firmly believes in the importance of seeking educational partner input prior to writing the LCAP plan. Gathering input is important and necessary to help us improve the educational experience and outcomes for our student(s).

Field Trip and Sports	Mrs. Pereida-Martinez is pleased to announce students return to field trips as Covid -19 restrictions ease. Extended Learning Opportunity Program Update	Emma Pereida-Martinez gave an overview of the ELOP requirements. "Expanded learning" means after school, summer, or intersession learning programs that focus on developing the academic, social, emotional, and physical needs and interests of pupils through hands-on, engaging learning experiences. She shared that AUSD will provide the first 10 out of 30 ELOP opportunities this July 5 th through July 18 th .
