Tuition Information

- A \$1,500 "multi-student" discount will apply for each additional K-12 student who is not receiving the Mennonite Education Plan rate.
- Tuition is billed and collected using a tuition management system (FACTS). Families have several payment options in FACTS. Fees are charged based on the option selected (\$50 annual fee for monthly billing, \$15 for semi-annual, \$5 for annual).
- FACTS offers various payment arrangements for families to choose from and customize. Dock tuition schedule is broken into ten monthly installments, August-May. Partial month enrollment still necessitates billing for that month, if applicable.
- A 2% discount will apply for families paid in full by August 15. The 2% discount will be reflected in FACTS for all families that choose "full pay." If full payment is not received by August 15, the 2% discount will be removed in FACTS, which will change the amount due.

Church Assistance

Some congregations provide financial assistance to families by paying all or part of the tuition cost. Contact your congregation to inquire about assistance they may provide.

Financial Aid

Our commitment is to be affordable for all families seeking Christian education. Dock provides more than \$1.5 million in tuition assistance to families annually—including tuition-paying families that also receive partial church assistance. Applications for tuition assistance may be obtained from the Admissions Office.

Visitation Days

Dock offers scheduled visitation days throughout the year, when prospective students will be hosted by a current student and experience a typical day, including classes, chapel, and a complimentary lunch.
