

Important Senior Information. PLEASE read the following carefully!

Prom Information

- Saturday, April 22 from 6:00-10:00pm at the Waterfront Hotel
- A buffet dinner is included, and guests are permitted.
- If your guest does not attend MHS, you must fill out a guest form. Guest forms may be picked up from Miss George's room (116) or Miss Parks' room (118) during homeroom or between classes. MHS underclassmen who are guests of seniors do not need a guest form.
- Guest forms must be submitted to the main office for approval no later than April 3 by 3pm.
- Tickets are \$50.00 per person; tickets will be sold March 6-April 14. Tickets cannot be purchased after April 14 (this is absolutely the final day to purchase tickets as we have to notify the venue for food preparation). Tickets will not be sold at the door.
- Tickets must be purchased via School Cash Online. If you have not registered for School Cash Online, go to the MHS homepage; click on the link at top right. See pg. 2 of this paper for specific directions.
- Once your guest is approved, guest tickets can be purchased under the MHS senior's name via School Cash Online.
- If your guest is an MHS underclassman, that ticket can be purchased under the MHS senior's name via School Cash Online. See Miss George or Miss Parks with questions.
- ****Once you have your ticket confirmation, go to Miss George's room (116) or Miss Parks' room (118) during homeroom or between classes to choose your table. Tables can hold up to 10 people. You must show ticket confirmation to choose your table.**
- March 21-Prom Chic Shop will be set up in the library for any student who would like to look for prom attire. There is no charge for this clothing. The time and procedure for students to visit the prom shop will be announced soon.

- Tickets can be purchased May 1-May 19 via School Cash Online. Tickets will not be sold at door.

- Please remember that parking at MHS is limited, so plan accordingly.

Graduation Day

- Saturday, May 27 at 10:00am at Pony Lewis Field. Weather could delay the 10am start time. Open seating; no tickets required. Seniors should arrive by 9:00am for line up. Rain time: Saturday, May 27 at 4:00pm. If inclement weather, a change of date or time will be determined, but please be prepared with rain gear just in case.

Parchment (Transcripts)

- All parchment/transcript info can be found on MHS Homepage, then Guidance & Counseling, then Transcript Request.
- All transcripts must be requested electronically at parchment.com.
- **After** final grades come out in mid-June, you **must** request a final transcript thru Parchment to be sent to the college of your choice.

Senior Pictures/Yearbook

- Yearbooks are \$60 and can be ordered by going to School Cash Online. Here are the steps:
 - MHS Homepage
 - In upper right corner, click on the 3 lines to click the Parents Tab
 - Scroll down to Register for School Cash Online Information
 - Click "register" option and complete the 3 registration steps
 - A registration confirmation email will be sent to you
 - Click on the link in the email to confirm email and School Cash Online account
 - The confirmation link will open the School Cash Online site
 - Sign into your account by using your email and password
 - Click on the event you are interested in (in this case "Yearbook")

Other Important Dates/Information

- March 1 during Flex-Senior Panoramic Photo. Students will be called to the gym via the intercom. A bus will transport MTEC and Excel graduating seniors to MHS so they can participate. Details about how to order this photo will be explained the day the photo is taken.
- May 15-Senior Chromebooks, cases, and charges will be collected. If charger is missing, you must pay a \$25 fee. If case is missing, you must pay a \$10 fee. If you are missing chromebook, charger, and case, the fee is \$225. **If you need your Chromebook past May 15, please see Ms. Rucker in the technology office at the top of the cafeteria and arrangements can be made.
