



TRANSFER STUDENTS IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

A student transferring from another school system in South Carolina or from another state must provide his/her South Carolina Immunization Certificate. An out-of-state student must take his/her immunization record to a doctor or health department to receive a South Carolina Certificate.

All incoming students with an international immunization record must take their immunization record to the health department for a South Carolina Certificate.

Please note any missing or non-compliant immunizations will need to be administered by a physician or health department before a South Carolina Immunization Certificate can be issued.

New residents may temporarily enroll their children in school for 30 days with a special exemption issued by the school until an immunization certificate can be obtained. If a certificate is not presented to the school at the end of the 30 days, the student will no longer be allowed to attend school

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
