Steps to Joining

1. Contact a recruiter in the branch you are interested in
2. Take the ASVAB (Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery)
3. Research your options - <https://www.todaysmilitary.com/>

Questions to Ask Recruiters

- **When do I take the ASVAB?**

- Be prepared and score as high as possible
- Recruiters may give you a practice test
- You can buy a study guide for the ASVAB

- **How soon will I leave for training?**

- Joining entails qualifying by testing and taking a physical
- After qualifying you pick your job and swear-in
- Discuss when you are available to leave

- **When will I get my job assigned?**

- Make sure you understand what job you have been assigned
- Know when you are leaving for basic training

- **What documents do I need to start the recruiting process?**

- Government issued ID
- Social Security Card
- High school diploma
- Birth certificate

- **Do you need my complete medical and legal history?**

- Complete medical history
- Legal infractions: traffic tickets, misdemeanors, felonies, etc.

Workforce

Apprenticeships

Apprenticeships are programs designed for students interested in the manufacturing/construction/plumbing/mechanical industries. Students must apply for these experiences and they typically last anywhere from 1-4 years. Students attend 2-year college courses while getting real-world experience at their sponsoring company. These can lead to lucrative, long term positions upon the completion of a successful apprenticeship.
